

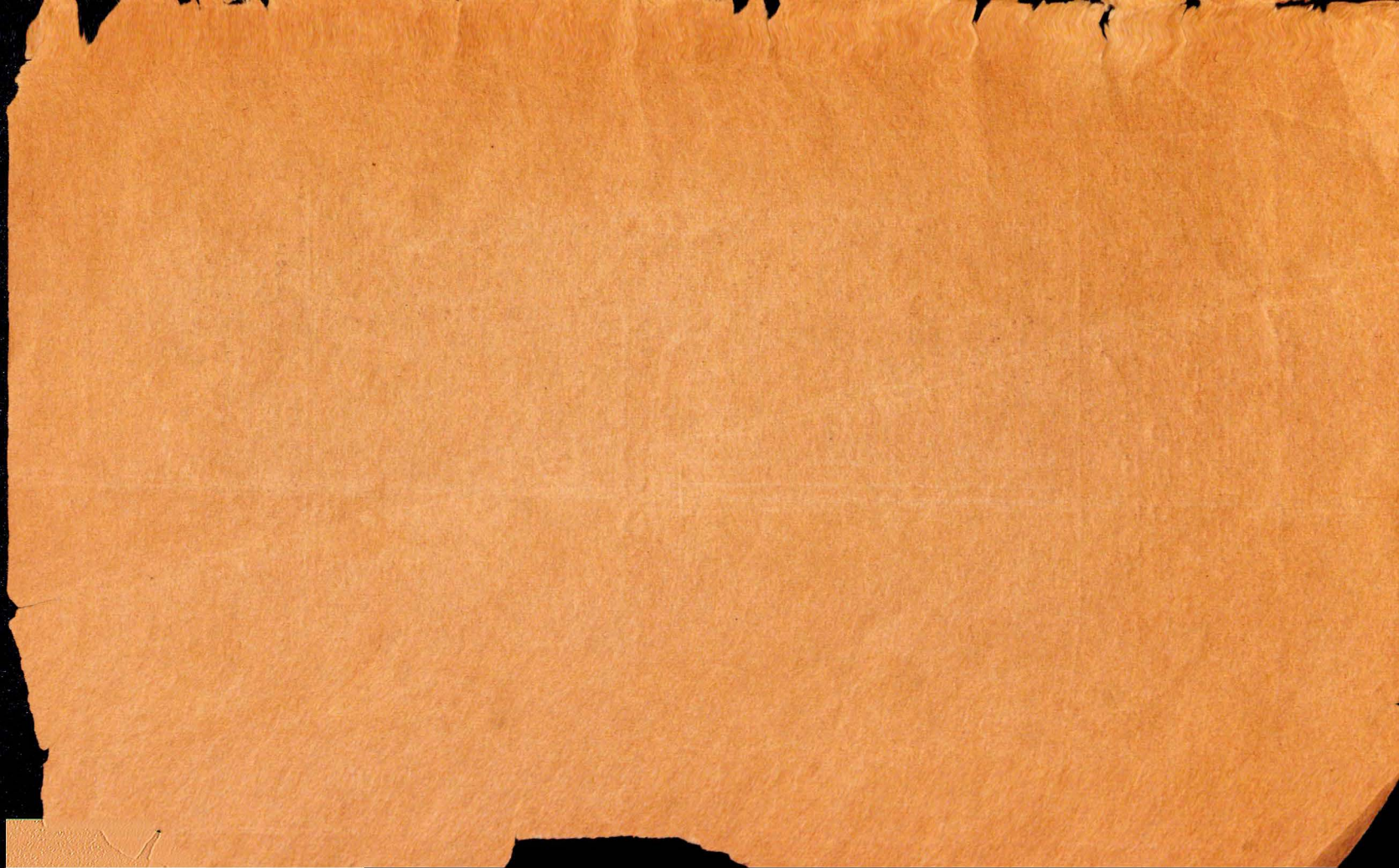

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Five Messages from the Lord.

INTRODUCTION

This prophetic vision was granted by God to one of His vessels in England, in accordance with His written word in Acts 2:17 and in Joel 2:28, which is quoted in part upon the cover of this booklet. The vision was given during three trances (comp. Peter in Acts 10:9-11, and Paul in Acts 22:17, 18, and in II Cor. 12:1-4), each of which commenced during a prayer meeting in a private house; the first after a communion service and the second after a baptismal service. The vision lasted from August 9th to 11th, and a resume of its contents was foretold three days before in the letter quoted below, written to a Christian brother from Camberley on August 6th and which has been carefully kept.

Camberley, Surrey,

6th August, 1919.

Dear Brother in the Lord Jesus:

All glory to His name. I have much to praise Him for. Last night the two sisters and myself had prayers before retiring to rest and I was filled with the Spirit and saw the Lord, Who said:

"In such an hour as ye think not." Then He vanished. But I saw Him in all His glory, and He was so lovely. I was so happy, I simply could not go to bed, so I waited upon Him and He came to me saying:—

"Be faithful unto Me, and I will show unto My servant what shall fall upon the children of the world who have and will reject Me. Thou shalt see the rapture of the dead in Christ, and the Bride of Christ translated. Thou shalt see the coming of the Antichrist, the false prophet, the sign of those who worship the beast, and who receive the mark of

Antichrist. Thou shalt also behold the two faithful witnesses, their labours, their martyrdom and the martyrdom of those who will not fall down and worship the beast. Thou shalt behold the resurrection of the two witnesses and their rapture, and then the horrors of those who are left behind. Thou shalt not fear, for I, the Lord, will be with thee when thou dost behold these things. For men shall know that there is a God among them, and shall also know that He has warned them through His servant, whether they will take heed or no."

I wonder what to make of this. I saw the Lord so vividly, with the marks in His hands and feet. Pray for me, that I may be faithful to Him.

Yours in the Lord Jesus,

Just after the first trance had commenced, the above letter was read out to four other people who had been at the prayer meeting, in order that they might know the nature of the vision God was revealing, and understand why, ever and anon, His vessel wailed, as if in great grief. It will be seen from what is described below, how accurately the nature of the vision was foretold; and from this the reader may deduce how surely the vision itself will come to pass in due time.

Those who do not know where to find these things in the Bible, which is the written Word of the Ever-living God, are referred to —

I. A vision in trance, lasting five hours, from 9:30 p. m., August 9th, to 2:30 a. m., August 10th, 1919.

2. During a prayer meeting I was in the Spirit, and fell into a trance; and, in a vision of God, I heard the blast of a trumpet, sudden, shrill and loud. I saw the Lord Jesus Christ descending from Heaven enveloped in a bright cloud. Again, I saw many graves burst open, and the dead in Christ rising therefrom to meet the Lord in the air. Following them, I also saw the living in Christ caught up to meet Him in the air. Alas, multitudes of those living upon the earth were left behind, and only a very, very small proportion of the graves were opened.

3. Immediately after the rapture, I saw those who had been left behind upon the earth visiting the graveyards

to examine those graves which had been opened by the Power of God. Great crowds of people, both rich and poor, congregated together to talk about this great event. Mothers were crying for the loss of their children, men were distressed for the loss of their wives and families, and wives for the loss of their husbands. These crowds were huge and the noise which they made was deafening.

4. Many people were crying out in repentance for their hardness of heart and unbelief in the past, and for having rejected the Word of God.

5. I saw numbers of ministers of every denomination. Some of these looked very sad; others tried to comfort the people; others again looked very displeased at having been left behind. Then the congregations began to mob their ministers, striking them,

and angrily asking them why, after listening to their doctrines, they also had not been caught up to meet the Lord when He came.

6. It was clear that many people were wishing that they had been obedient to the Word of God, and that others, who had opposed the doctrine in the Word of God held by those who had been translated, wished that they had listened to it instead. On the contrary, it was also clear that many were very glad indeed at the departure of God's children, and tried to justify themselves by declaring that it was the devil who had taken them away!

7. Then the scene changed, and I saw the people going on with their ordinary occupations and pleasures, for they seemed to have forgotten all about the translation of God's children. Everywhere were places of amusement fitted with pretty shaded lights of many colours, and into these places multitudes of people entered. Outside most of them large posters were to be seen; while inside, men, women, young lads and girls were lounging about, smoking, drinking and playing cards, many of whom were only partly dressed.

been churches, had been converted into these places of amusement and riot, where drink was being sold.

9. Only a very few churches remained open for God's work, and I could see and hear the Ministers in charge of them telling their congregations to keep firm and be ready to suffer anything for the Lord Jesus Christ. From some in the congregations would come a very earnest "Amen," from others a curse or a laugh of scorn. Most of those who comprised these congregations would enter these churches without taking off their hats, and would then read newspapers and smoke peacefully while the service was going on!

10. No altar for administering the Lord's supper was to be seen, for the Lord had only instituted this until He came,* and, as He had come, it was no longer observed.

11. I beheld large fires lighted in open waste places, and even in the streets, into which the people threw their Bibles, prayer books, and other devotional works. The crowds which grew larger and larger, were delighted

at the destruction of these books.

Then followed a time of great trouble, during which I saw two men witnessing for God. The first was an old man with long flowing white hair, while the second was much younger and had dark hair, which only came down to his shoulders.

13. Each of them was dressed in a long, dark garment of sackcloth, which looked somewhat like a dressing gown.

14. Each wore a girdle about his waist, and each carried a Bible in his hand. On their faces, which were beautiful, was a look of wonderful peace.

14. Both these witnesses went about separately, pushing their way in and out of the crowds, testifying to the people of the terrible times that were coming upon them, and showing them that the only way of salvation left for them was by enduring suffering for the Lord Jesus Christ.

16. They told the people how they had been warned all through the ages, and they read to them out of God's Word about the days of Noah, telling them that even worse things should befall them.

17. A few people would believe them but most of them would laugh at what they said, and drive hither and thither, persecute or kill, the few who did believe. Many who did believe were martyred for it, and died rejoicing in their sufferings for Christ, accepting the testimony of the two witnesses concerning the great joy which would be theirs by overcoming. Others were protected by the power of God from being killed, and went about preaching the Word of God.

18. The two witnesses kept on ever warning and encouraging the great masses of the people, but after a time they called upon God to send famine upon the earth, and immediately fields of corn, wheat or barley were withered up and scorched by a great heat.

19. Then the terrible times which had been foretold began, and the people rushed upon the two witnesses to kill them; but, as they attempted to strike them with their weapons, fire came from their mouths and destroyed those who tried to injure them.

20. Then these two witnesses did other mighty miracles; for they spoke

to the sea and immediately it became blood; and again they spoke, and then followed great thunderings and lightnings.

21. Then I beheld a strange and hideous creature* rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten short horns. One of its heads was like the head of a huge serpent and was terribly mutilated on its right side, but the wound was dried up and healed, leaving terrible scars. The four feet of the beast were like the feet of a bear and it walked very silently.

22. Again, I saw a second beast come up out of the earth. It looked rather like a goat, and had only two short horns like a lamb, and it kept standing upon its hind legs.

These two beasts had great power, and did many mighty acts; for fire came down from heaven at their command. The people, who seemed to be very great in number, began to worship these two strange beings. Then the second beast, which had the two short horns, desired that they should make an image of the first beast, which had seven heads and ten horns, and this was done.

24. Then I saw the people going about apparently purchasing badges different quality and made of various materials of different value, on which the number or the mark of the beast, or both, were to be seen. **The number** was three sixes, with the heads of the sixes shaped like the heads of serpents.

25. The mark of the beast appeared to be three heads, one like that of a horrible goat, the centre one like that of a serpent, and the third like that of an eagle.

26. These badges were worn by the people on their hands or on their foreheads, or on both; and, in some cases, it appeared as if the mark and number were tattooed upon them in these places.

27. When the people had procured their marks, they would fall down and worship the image of the seven-headed beast.

28. Then a wonderful thing happened, for the image of the beast began to speak, and among other blasphemous things said, "I am God."

29. Those who would not have the mark of the beast were either starved or terribly tortured with hot irons,

knives, swords, hatchets, and spears; and their cries of pain were terrible. Some had their hands cut off, others their arms or legs.

30. Those who were faithful were tortured to death; but some gave in after being tortured for a while, and worshipped the image of the beast; whereupon they were healed and nourished by the beast, who worked miracles for them.

31. Some received the mark of the beast, but refused to receive the number of his name; whereupon they were tortured until they died; after which they were healed and fed by the beast.

32. Then I saw both beasts in the form of men.

33. Now, when the two witnesses of God had finished their testimony, they were beheaded, and their bodies were left lying about in the streets, which seemed to be full of people and to be also covered with dirt and with blood.

34. The people were so delighted at the death of these two witnesses that, instead of burying their bodies, they trampled upon them, and kicked their heads about the street.

35. Then a wonderful thing happened, for their heads came on to their bodies again, and they stood upright upon their feet.

36. Then a great and beautiful cloud appeared, and a loud voice came out of the cloud, saying:—

"COME UP HITHER."

37. Then the two witnesses ascended up into Heaven in the sight of their enemies; and, following them, I saw many, who had been martyred for God and left unburied, come to life and ascend into Heaven also.

38. Then the earth was filled with darkness, and there were great thunderings and an earthquake, and I saw the buildings falling down, amid groanings, and weepings, and wailings, which filled me full of agony for the people.

39. Then I saw into the heavens, and beheld seven beautiful angels, each holding a vessel in his hand.

II. A vision in trance lasting 12½ hours, from 10:30 p. m., August 10th, to 10:45 a. m., August 11th, 1919.

2. Again I was in the Spirit, and saw in a vision a great sea, which

shone like ice in moonlight and on which great flashes of fire were reflected. Standing upon this sea, I beheld those people who had overcome the beast during the great tribulation, and who had not received either his mark or the number of his name. They had harps in their hands, and sang praises to God in beautiful strains of music, and I heard the words:—

3. "Great and marvellous are Thy works, Lord God Almighty. Just and true are Thy ways, Thou King of saints. And Thou hast caused Thy judgments to become manifest."

4. Again I saw the seven angels, which I had seen at the end of the above vision, clothed in pure white raiment with golden girdles round their breasts.

5. Then I beheld a living creature having a face like a man, who gave unto the seven angels seven golden vessels filled with the wrath and judgments of God.

6. Above me I could see a shining temple, which was enveloped in light and glory, and I also was covered with the glory of God. Then I heard a loud voice saying:—

7. "Now is the time. Go your ways and pour out the vials of the wrath and judgments of God, which He will cause to fall upon the earth"; whereupon the seven angels departed on their several ways.

8. The first angel lifted up his hand and turned his vial upside down, and from it there descended as it were a cloud, which was the power of God's judgment. When the cloud descended, the people on the earth, who all seemed to wear the mark of the beast were afflicted with an awful running sore.

9. The second angel poured out his vial over the sea, and the sea became like blood, but lighter in colour than blood from an ordinary wound. There were ships upon the sea which were overturned, and the crews of which perished.

10. The third angel poured out his vial upon the fountains and rivers, and they also became as blood; and I could hear a voice saying:—

11. They have shed the blood of Thy saints and prophets, and they are worthy to drink blood."

12. The fourth angel poured out his vial on the sun, and it became intensely hot, so that all men became as charred wood, and cursed God as they were scorched.

13. The fifth angel poured out his vial upon millions of people and they were enveloped in great darkness, and they cried and groaned, and cursed God in their pain.

14. The sixth angel poured out his vial upon a very broad river, and it was immediately dried up and became as dry land.

15. The seventh angel poured out his vial upon the earth, and I heard the same loud voice saying:—

"IT IS FINISHED."

16. Then I saw the earth reeling to and fro like a drunken man, and I heard deafening noises.

17. Then I beheld the first angel having a key in his hand, and he took hold of the two beasts and cast them into the lake of fire. Then he seized hold of that great serpent, which is Satan, and cast him into a very dark place full of dense smoke, and there I was told he must stay for one thousand years.

18. Then all who had been martyred for the Lord Jesus during the great tribulation, lived with Him and reigned with Him over the earth; and I could see companies of them descending to the earth from time to time, and ascending again into heaven to bring glory to the Lord, Who sat upon the throne in heaven.

19. After one thousand years Satan, whose appearance was that of a huge serpent, was let loose again. With him I saw a great army of those who followed him, trying to kill the saints of God then living upon the earth; but fire came down from heaven and consumed them; and Satan, who reigned over them, was cast into the lake of fire.

The End of the World.

20. Then I saw the blue sky rent in the midst, and at each edge of the rent it was rolled quickly back as a roll of paper might be. The earth also disappeared, and in its place I beheld an empty void.

21. Then I beheld multitudes of men, women and children of all races, who had been dead, standing before the throne of the Lord Jesus. The

names of these were found to be written in the Book of Life.

22. Then I saw the sea giving up its remaining dead, and Hell (which appeared to be like a large field of fires) released those who were therein, and all were judged. Alas, the names of these, among whom, praise God, I saw no children, were not found written in the Book of Life.

23. Then I beheld a new earth which was very beautiful, and I saw a new heaven take the place of that one which had passed away. In this new heaven there was no sun, nor moon, nor stars. In the place of the blue sky, belt or envelope, which had been rolled up, and which had passed away, I saw a new one of glory, as it were, of golden brightness. There was no night upon the new earth, but it was always light, and the people who dwelt thereon were filled with joy and happiness.

24. The vision changed, and I was carried away by a beautiful angel up and up through space to the blue sky or envelope, which now is, and through which I passed, into a second space; through a second and red belt or envelope, into a third space; through a third and purple belt, or envelope, into a fourth space; through a fourth and golden belt, or envelope, into a fifth space; through a fifth and many coloured belt, or envelope, into a sixth space; and lastly, through a sixth and dazzling white belt, or envelope, into a seventh space.

25. Here I beheld a number of people, with crowns upon their heads, clothed in shining white robes and holding palms in their hands, who were singing praises unto God.

26. The angel told me that these were the **Bride of Christ**, and consisted of those who were found in Christ at His second coming, and who had been caught up to meet Him in the air. They were all enveloped in, and filled with, the Glory of God, and had beautiful mansions of various colours which also shone with the Glory of God. From the least to the greatest, all sought but one thing, namely, to glorify Him.

27. Alas, even as I could behold the glories of heaven, so also I could see the horrors of the lake of fire, and Satan therein reigning over the great

multitudes of people, who had chosen to serve him while they lived upon the earth, and who had rejected the Lord Jesus Christ. Forever they were doomed to worship Satan, whom they had chosen, in the awful torments of the lake of fire.

III. A vision in trance lasting half an hour, from 9 to 9:30 p. m., August 11th, 1919.

2. Again I was in the Spirit, and saw the Lord Jesus standing before me, with the marks of the nails in His hands and feet, and the marks of the thorns upon His brow. As I knelt at His feet He said:—

3. "I will cause My Word, which I have spoken through My servant, to go north and south, east and west. Many shall say, Ye have added unto My Word; many shall say, Ye have taken away from My Word; but I say unto thee, This is My Word, which is the Sword of the Spirit, and the Spirit of prophecy."

A MESSAGE FROM THE LORD JESUS CHRIST

INTRODUCTION

This beautiful and illuminating prophecy was given to one of His chosen vessels in England in seventy-five visions. Almost every time the word came the Lord Jesus Himself appeared; and either manifested a scroll on which the prophecy was written and from which it was copied, or else in an audible voice dictated the prophecy to His servant, who wrote it down as He spoke it. Frequently the prophecy would break off in the middle of a sentence, and, being continued anything one to twenty-seven days later, was found to exactly fit what had gone before. Thus it was known to be one continuous message, although the way in which it was given varied.

First the Lord appeared to His servant and spoke, saying: "That which thou shalt see with thine eyes and hear with thine ears, write in a book."

A few days later, on April 20th, 1920, He began to give this prophecy, which He finished seven months later, on Nov. 20th. During these seven months He gave the word on forty days by His audible voice, on twenty-five days by manifesting the scroll, and on ten days in both these ways.

A careful study of the Bible will reveal that the word of the Lord came to His prophets in quite a variety of different ways: such, for example, as:—

1. The Lord speaking Face to face with His prophets. (Gen. 28:1-33; Num. 12:6-8.)
2. The audible Voice of God to His prophets. (Gen. 22:1; 1 Sam. 3:4, 5, 11-14; John 12:28; Acts 8:29 and 10:19.)

3. The manifestation to God's prophets by the Holy Spirit of a book or scroll containing the word or message of God." (Ezek. 2:9; Zech. 5:1-3; Rev. 10:2, 8, 11.)

"The world seeth Me no more; but ye see Me." (John 14:19.)

"I will manifest Myself." (John 14:21.)

The division of the prophecy into sections and the numbering of the paragraphs has been done for purposes of reference.

I. A MESSAGE FROM THE LORD JESUS CHRIST,

Who changeth not, Who is always the same, yesterday, to-day, and forever.

2. As the people of the world read My words, which are Life and Truth, for they are Spirit, so shall the old man be put off and the New Man, the Christ of God, be put on. Ye shall know the reality of a Living God moving upon and within you: for what saith the Word of God?

3. "The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit."

4. But how many, who have read My words, experience this wonderful truth? How many have felt the Holy Spirit of God moving upon them even as they feel the wind and hear it when it ariseth? This must be the experience of all those who follow Me.

5. Ye say among yourselves, We understand this not; and ye pass it by. Therefore hear the words of the Lord your God. He that hath not been born of the Spirit hath not the Spirit of God neither knoweth Him.

6. Now the Spirit of God is manifested in many ways by the same Spirit; and every one shall know in his or her heart if they have been born of God. Prophecy, either past or future, shall be revealed to many; and visions either past or future, to many more. Tongues, interpretation of tongues, and miracles, all confirming My word, shall follow those who are the children of God. The sick shall be healed by prayer and faith, and many signs and wonders shall be done in My Father's Name.

7. Know ye not, all ye that read My words, that the Lord God is alive for evermore and changeth not? He is the same yesterday, to-day, and for

ever. The god that many worship is like unto the gods of the heathen. They see not, hear not, feel not, neither do they speak nor understand. Ye are against all those who worship idols, gods of wood and stone; yet many treat Me as though I were made of stone.

8. I am ALIVE for evermore; and I desire to speak and manifest Myself in many ways to My own children. I am against all those who will not let Me work the mighty works of God My Father in their midst. How can ye believe that I am alive? Unto nearly the whole world I am as one dead; because ye will not believe, neither obey, My written word.

9. Have I not said, The earth shall be filled with the knowledge of God as the waters cover the sea? Think ye that I mean only the knowledge of My word, which ye call the Scriptures, shall cover the earth? I, the Lord, say unto you that in the last days God shall send forth His word in mighty power. His word has not ceased from among men, for the word of God has neither beginning nor end. I am Alpha and Omega. My word shall go forth through My children until time shall be no more. They who accept My word shall have joy in the Holy Ghost, and shall see the Salvation of the Lord; but those who reject it shall be shut out of the kingdom, and punishment shall fall upon all those who stretch forth their hands to harm My servants who give forth My Word.

II. The Lord your God would have you know many things for your spiritual growth. Ye are living in days of great darkness. The whole world lieth in the evil one, whose time is short. Watch and pray lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit desires to serve Me, but the flesh is with which he seeks to delude the children of God.

2. Many, who have tasted the wonderful love of God and have seen the mysteries of the Kingdom, have been beguiled by Satan. They have not obeyed My voice; therefore he has come as an angel of light, even as God Himself; for unto him is given power to work miracles. I say unto you again, Watch and pray, lest he take

you unawares, for he is a biting serpent and a stinging adder.

3. Flee, My children, to your Saviour, and ye will experience the love and peace of God in Christ filling your souls. The devil shall not harm My faithful children; for your Lord is the Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace; whose going forth has been from of old, from everlasting, whose dominion shall not pass away; for His Kingdom is that which shall never be destroyed. Therefore, take courage in thy God, for He is thy refuge and thy exceeding great reward.

4. Therefore, seeing by My word that the world lieth in the evil one, is it not high time for thee to look about thee and gain an entrance into the Ark of God's Kingdom? Not every one that saith, Lord, Lord, shall enter into My Father's Kingdom. Few there be walking the straight and narrow way. These are they who have been faithful to My commands. The Lord thy God hath laid down in His word the conditions for an entrance into His Kingdom:—

1. Repentance from the heart.

2. Baptism by water, believing in the manifested Power of Jesus Christ.

3. Receiving the same Power, the same Spirit by the baptism of the Holy Ghost with signs and wonders following.

8. Thy Lord desires to bring His children into the deep knowledge of God and to show them things to come. Wilt thou not yield thyself unto thy Lord Who has done so much for thee? He would have thee say, "We are come unto Mount Zion, and unto the city of the Living God, the Heavenly Jerusalem. He would bring thee there into Emmanuel's land and commune with thee, revealing the glories of His Kingdom. There shall the names of My children be written in the Blood of the Lamb: they shall praise Jesus the Mediator, and gaze upon the everlasting throne where He shall reign; and they shall find peace and joy in the Ark where the Glory of God dwelleth—even in Christ Himself.

III. My children, My children, behold the glories of the New Jerusalem, behold the Lamb that was slain before the foundation of the earth, be-

hold the Lord of lords and King of kings. He is thy Saviour, He is thy Lord—even Jesus the Son of God—Who left the highest heaven and walked this earth, bearing sin and shame for all men that ye might have life. The tomb could not hold the Son of God. He rose again, and pleads for His own before His Father's throne.

2. Therefore shall your hearts rejoice, all ye who follow Me; for the promise of the Father shall be given to all who are obedient unto My word. My children shall say with great joy in their hearts, The Temple of the Holy Ghost am I. They shall experience the Living Christ, being fed with the Spirit of God without measure. They shall drink from the fountain of Living Water deep and wide, and their eyes unveiled shall behold the Glory of the King.

IV. The Kingdom of Heaven is opened to all believers. Now he who believeth on the Lord Jesus Christ must be an ardent follower of Him, not accepting His word in part but the whole. Many say, He that believeth on the Lord Jesus Christ shall be saved. Many believe I came down from heaven by the will of the Father; believe I died and rose again and ascended into heaven; believe I am seated on the right hand of the Father, and think this is the meaning of My word "believe." This is one way in which Satan, that old serpent, deceives those who think they are the children of God.

2. Oh, ye blind and ignorant people, know ye not that I am against those who read my word and obey it not. If ye believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, His will will be your will, and ye will delight in obeying His commands.

3. The word of the Lord came unto Moses—the Lord spake with him Face to face—and to all His servants the prophets, either by hearing of the ear, by vision, prophecy or dreams.

4. Ye are ignorant and dull in understanding My word. Think ye that the Lord hath kept silent since the last revelation which ye read in the word of God unto My servant John? As I have spoken before so will I speak again. My word shall continue out

of the mouth of God, feeding My hungry children, for the harvest is white and the labourers are few.

V. Harken unto the words of God, all ye who desire to follow Me. I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; in Me ye will find eternity. I have a work to work in My children, that they may be ready when I return.

2. The blessing of the Lord is upon all who hunger and thirst after Righteousness. The living Christ shall satisfy them with Himself. Therefore take courage and look unto the Lord your God, and He shall guide you into the green pastures prepared for all those who follow Him. Peace and joy is the portion of those who find in Me their satisfaction; but few there be who have reached this state, because many are called but few are chosen.

3. My children must press on through this Babylon of sin and shame, calling upon Me moment by moment, and resting in Me. Thy Lord had nowhere to lay His head; therefore, think not that thou shalt find rest in this wilderness of sin. The Lord thy God hath invited thee into His Kingdom. Wilt thou follow Him and obey Him, **SIX—PROPHETIC VISIONS**—that thou mayest enter? He goeth before thee, and He is the Way.

4. My children, as ye walk through this Babylon of sin, I the Lord, will be with you. Remember My word, that when the enemy would seek to lure you away, I will deliver you from his attacks.

5. As I am not of the world, neither are My children. They long for their Father's home, and weary of the evil world. As ye journey onward towards that heavenly city your walk with Me shall become your one desire, and the world will have no attraction, because the world is an enemy of your Lord.

6. Babylon lives again in the world to-day, swimming in sin, cruelty and darkness. Great shall be her fall, because she repenteth not of her sins. Her pride is very great; she remembereth not her God who died for the whole world and whose love would embrace all who come unto Him; and she rejects Him and His works. Her fall shall be very terrible, because of the grace, the mercy, and the word of

God which she hath spurned. 7. Therefore, hear the word of the Lord, all ye that dwell upon the earth. Turn unto Me, turn unto Me while the mercy and forgiveness of God are obtainable. Soon, soon, will My Father say, My Son, no longer shall My Spirit strive with man; pour out, pour out the righteous anger and wrath of God upon this godless earth; make it waste and void, for the sin and wickedness of this people shall no longer reign.

VI. As My children receive Me into their hearts, sin shall no longer reign there. They shall become like unto their Lord Who is their example. No condemnation or torment of fire shall frighten them; because the comfort of the Holy Ghost shall sustain them through this little while. They shall say with My servant, He is My Rock, My strength; He is My Defense, and I shall not be moved.

2. Beautiful shall the robes of My children be as they follow their Lord each day; for they shall have robes of spotless white, even the righteousness of God.

3. My children must wholly depend upon Me, love, trust, and obey Me in all things: for they who are obedient grow in grace and knowledge of God.

4. Thou must be prepared to leave all, to take up My cross—the cross of rejection—and follow Me. Thou shalt not be ashamed of thy Lord; for sweet shall be thy walk with Me.

5. Thou shalt not turn aside from following Me when thou seest Me before thee; for I, the Lord, desire to make My abode with My children. It is not enough to see thy Lord to-day and not to-morrow; He would have thee know Him altogether.

6 The crown of Life and of Righteousness shall be given unto those who are obedient unto My words. They shall make ready a room in their hearts where I may dwell.

7. My children, who would follow deep into the mysteries of God, must shut out the whole world and lean only on their Lord. They will prepare the fairest place where they can talk with their Beloved. Many of My children shall rejoice with joy unspeakable as they behold My glory

face to face. They will not be satisfied with man's teaching; but will continually cry unto their Father Who alone can feed them with the word of Life.

8. The Lord God hath a few shepherds who feed His flocks; and these shall have their reward as they receive My word and send it forth.

VII. To-day the churches of the world have many beliefs, doctrines, creeds, rites and rituals; but they know not the Lord God, and they are far from the Kingdom of God. The shepherds know Me not, see Me not, and hear Me not. How, therefore, can they feed My sheep?

2. I, the Lord, desire My children to be fed by shepherds who know Me. They shall have spiritual food and spiritual wisdom as they obey their Lord. But the churches to-day are asleep. A great worldly spirit is stealing over the people, hushing them, lest they should awake and find their need for food which will satisfy their hunger. Entertainments, concerts, and places of amusement are luring the people away from Me. Ye entertain and make merry in the places ye have called the houses of God! Remember ye not what the Lord Jesus did unto those He found in the temple making merchandise? He drove them out. Even so will He do unto all those who make merry in the places which ye call the houses of God.

3. Is it not enough to know that I know you not, that ye should provoke Me to anger with your hypocrisy and idolatry?

4. Ye seek the praises of man and not of God. Your prayers and your works shall perish. Unless ye turn unto Me and obey My commands ye shall perish likewise; for the coming of the Lord draweth very near.

5. Only a few will be saved, only a few will be ready to meet Me in the air; because, when I have spoken unto you through My servants the prophets and prophetesses, ye have laughed and made ridicule of My words.

6. I am the Lord Who would do wonders amongst you if ye hearkened unto My words; but ye have altogether gone your own way, and have treated My Father's words lightly!

Therefore, hear the words of the Lord. He who heareth My word and doeth it not shall be numbered with the transgressors, whose end is destruction; he shall be shut out forever from the Presence of the Lord into the lake of eternal fire; yea, nearly the whole world.

7. Ye say among yourselves, Our God is a God of Love, and will not punish His children eternally; and ye continue in sin. But what saith the Lord God? The soul that sinneth, it shall die. That soul shall not taste eternal Life, because it hath not repented.

8. These are the words of the Lord God, Who is the same yesterday, to-day, and forever. If a man abide not in Me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. For I am the true vine, and My Father is the Husbandman.

VIII. As My children follow Me they will continually seek My Face; they will abide in Me and I in them, strengthening them: for the world will hate them and persecute them, even as it did their Lord.

2. Weep not, My children, My chosen and faithful ones; for the darkness will flee away, and ye shall behold the glories of the New Jerusalem and find rest in your Lord. Many shall behold the Glory of God, which hitherto I, Jesus, have made known to them in vision. Ye shall become priests and kings unto God, doing His will, shining as stars in the Kingdom of God, and with the thousands that cannot be numbered assembled around the throne, praising your Lord for the Lamb which was slain from the foundation of the world.

IX. Ye people, who dwell upon the face of the earth, hearken unto the words of the Lord your God.

2. How many know the mystery of the Kingdom of God?

3. How many have tasted the wonderful word of God?

4. How many have drunk from the fountain of Living Water, which is flowing for the thirsty—even the Spirit of the Living God?

5. How many are hungry for the Righteousness of God?

6. Where are they who seek My Face, and who hear My voice?

7. Hear the words of the Lord, all ye people. Turn unto Me while I may be found. Obey My word by fulfilling My commands; for the Lord your God will open His good treasury unto all who follow Him. Therefore leave the fleshpots of "Egypt" and turn unto the Lord your God; and He shall satisfy you with the Spirit of the Living God. The Word became flesh and dwelt among men, healing, teaching, working miracles, and doing many wondrous works. Yet for all this He was despised and rejected of men! The day in which the Lord left His Father's home in Glory to dwell among sinful men began His life of rejection. There was no room for Him in the inn, for it was full. Anywhere would do for the humble maiden to bring forth her son, even the Lord of lords and King of kings. Oxen and asses shared the room with your Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

8. Hear the words of the Lord your God, all ye who desire to follow Me. The world is full of people to-day who are filled with their own pleasures; they have no room in their hearts for the Lord. As it was in the day when the Saviour was born, so it is in this sinful and proud generation.

9. Therefore hear the words of the Lord, all ye people. These are the last days, plainly spoken of in the Word of God. Terrible judgments are about to fall upon all those who persistently reject the mercy and the love of God.

10. These are the days when God promised to pour out His Spirit upon all flesh as He did at Pentecost. Many are experiencing this wonderful promise, seeing, hearing, and knowing—not in theory but in reality—the wonderful love of God. These shall have the joy of being caught up to meet their Lord with the saints, and shall partake of the marriage supper of the Lamb, so escaping the awful judgments which will fall upon the earth.

11. After My chosen ones have entered the joy of their Lord, then shall follow a time of great sorrow. Satan and his host shall rule the earth for seven years. Antichrist will devour millions and millions of people who ac-

cept his mark on their hand or forehead, thus being branded for ever to eternal punishment.

12. Get ready. Make haste quickly, for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh. The feet of iron and clay of My servant's vision will soon pass away, when the Lord Jesus Christ shall have come for His own. Repent of thy sins and turn unto the Lord thy God while there is time. Be not numbered among those who say, Where is the promise of His coming? for all things continue as they did at the beginning. Remember the days of Noah how he warned the people to flee from sin and wickedness and to turn unto the Lord. Nevertheless they would not hearken unto him. They were occupied with their own amusements, and would not be warned. They laughed to scorn the words of My servant the prophet, and they perished.

13. Therefore, hear the words of the Lord your God, Who is the same yesterday, to-day, and forever. Unless ye obey My words and repent of your sins ye shall likewise perish. For the people have waxed old in sin and degradation, and many who call themselves "Christians" are an abomination in My Father's sight, because they obey men rather than God. Many shepherds and flocks are scattered away from the fold of Christ, and no longer accept His atonement for their salvation.

14. Therefore, watch ye and pray always that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things and stand before the Son of Man unashamed and clothed with the Righteousness of God.

15. My children shall know Me when I come for them, and with great joy shall they praise their Lord, Whose coming they have waited for so patiently. As they soar into the Heavenly Jerusalem they will experience the wonderful peace of God filling them; their raiment shall be a robe of Love, Joy, and Peace—the Righteousness of God—; their tears shall no longer flow; they shall be satisfied, and shall gaze with wonder on the Lamb of God, Whose wonderful love and sacrifice has won for them such a glorious inheritance in the kingdom of God.

X. Hear the words of the Lord, all ye people, ye careless, ye wayward, ye unbelieving, ye ignorant, ye self-righteous, ye hypocritic, ye lukewarm Christians, and all ye who desire to know the Lord. I am the Lord, the Mighty One, the Lord of Hosts is My Name. There is neither beginning nor ending to My greatness. Behold, all that your eyes see is My creation. I am the Lord, and beside Me there is none other. Mine eyes behold all things, both small and great, upon the earth and in the sea.

2. Therefore, oh man, remember thou art My creation, and hearken unto the words of the Lord thy God, which I have spoken before and will speak again. I am the Lord, and beside Me there is none other. All power is given unto Me. I make the earth empty and void; I turn it upside down and scatter the inhabitants thereof; and no man can say, What doest Thou, or stay Mine hand.

3. I am the Lord. I will speak in these last days words which shall be easily understood; yet for all this ye will not hearken, for ye are a wayward people full of unrighteousness. Unless ye turn unto Me with all your hearts and worship Me, I, the Lord, will pour out upon the earth the swift fury of God. Sword, pestilence, and famine shall rage through the earth: and a sound of weeping, lamentation, and woe shall fill the earth: for ye have become worse than your fathers in following after sin, and ye have turned aside from following the Lord your God.

4. I am a jealous God, and will not suffer the wicked to prolong his days, but he shall be cut off in anguish, sorrow, and pain. The nations of the earth have been at war with each other, and much is the blood of the slain that has been shed; but this shall be counted as a very small thing when the sword of the Lord shall come upon the earth.

4. Where is your righteousness, love or justice? With your lips ye make a show of profession, but with your hearts ye blaspheme My Holy Name! Therefore, unless ye turn unto Me with all your hearts, your habitation and dwelling place shall become waste, your house shall be left unto you desolate and your prayers be unavailing:

for the Spirit of the Lord shall not always strive with man.

6. Therefore, seeing My Father's Spirit shall not always strive with man, seek ye the Lord while He may be found. Multitudes, more than ye can number, have been cut off from the Lord, for their time had come when the Spirit of the Lord would no longer strive with them. Millions perished in the plague which swept through the earth but a short time ago.

7. Therefore all ye who read My words, hearken unto the words of the Lord spoken unto you by the Spirit of God through an earthen vessel. Unless ye obey My words and turn from your sins unto the Living God ye shall likewise perish. Great shall be the plague, famine, pestilence and sword which are soon coming upon the earth: for the nations of the earth have provoked the Lord with their wickedness. The people of the earth have become mad.

8. Blackness and confusion shall come upon all those who reject My words, but the faithful and the obedient shall escape these terrible times which are about to fall upon the earth.

9. Many who read these words shall say, Hath the Lord spoken thus? Will He not turn His anger from us?

10. Remember the word of the Lord which ye see and read and know. Sore punishment fell upon all those who sinned against the Lord and rejected His word and His prophets. They were slain by the sword, they perished with hunger in the famine, they were destroyed by earthquakes, pestilences, plagues and sudden death.

11. Think ye to escape all these things, all ye who will not turn unto Me and live? The Lord your God is a jealous God, a very jealous God, and will not suffer the wicked doer to go unpunished. Therefore, unless ye turn unto the Lord quickly, ye shall perish.

12. When the judgments of the Lord are in the earth, then shall ye learn righteousness.

XI. The joy and peace of the Lord shall reign in the hearts of all those who read and accept My word. The words of man are as chaff, hay and stubble, and cannot satisfy the hungry

heart. The words of the Lord are Life and Truth, bringing joy and peace to those who love the Lord, and bringing conviction and repentance to many who hitherto have gone their own way. Many shall turn unto the Lord as they read My words and believe them. Many shall behold the Lord their God Who changeth not. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever. As they behold the Face of the Lord their God they will remember My word, which I spake unto those who followed Me, before I ascended to the Glory of My Father's Kingdom:—

2. "He that hath My commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth Me; and he that loveth Me shall be loved of My Father, and I will love him, and will manifest Myself unto him."

3. Believest thou the word of the Lord thy God? Behold the time has come when the Lord God will no longer speak in parables unto His faithful children, neither in proverbs: for the Lord—even Jesus—shall reveal unto them plainly the Father's power and the glories of the Kingdom of God.

4. Turn ye, turn ye unto the Lord, all ye who hunger and thirst after righteousness; for I am thy Righteousness. All ye who have found the world empty (satisfying only the children of darkness, who desire not the Light and whose god is Satan), seek ye the Lord; and He will satisfy thee with Living Bread—Bread which proceedeth out of the mouth of God. For He is that Bread which came down from heaven, that all they who eat thereof may live.

5. My children must be willing to be hated for their Lord's sake. Think ye, all ye who desire to follow Me, that ye will find friendship with the world while ye follow your Lord? Nay, I say unto you, ye must love not the world, for the world is an enemy of your Lord.

7. My children shall find all they need in their Lord; and great shall be their joy as they follow on to know the mysteries of the Kingdom of God. Mine arms are stretched out wide—full of blessings for those who will accept them. Why stand ye gazing? Draw near and behold the majesty of God.

XII. As thou dost behold even that which thou canst see with thine earthly eyes, seest thou not how small thou art in My sight? I can say unto thee, "Begone"; and thou art no more! and "Come up higher"; and thou arisest. Who art thou, oh man, that thou shouldst set thyself up, rejecting thy Lord and going thine own way?

2. The Lord your God thundereth from heaven. Ye nations, ye nations, be warned; ye are heaping unto yourselves damnation and destruction. Ye governors and rulers and all ye who are set in authority, hear the words of the Lord your God. Do ye enquire of the Lord your God for the people of your nation and of other nations? Did I not reveal My mighty Power in sending forth My angelic* servants to fight in the battle which swept through the earth but a short time ago? Were not My angelic servants seen by many? Yea; and, had I not put forth My hand in the battle, ye would have become swept and gar-nished.

3. Therefore, all ye who are in authority, remember the mercy and the joy of God. Remember that thy God is a God who doeth wonders great and terrible. Ye who guide and rule the nations of the earth, remember your Lord, that He is God.

4. The Most High God ruleth and reigneth in the Kingdom of God. The Lord God would have you know the Power of God, the Power which shaketh the whole heaven and earth, the Power which brought your Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ from the tomb, the Power which carried Him into the heavenly Kingdom and seated Him on the right hand of the Majesty of God, the Power of God which shall descend when the Lord Jesus Christ shall descend into the clouds for His own, the Power of God which fills the children of obedience, revealing unto them the wonderful truths of a Manifest Christ.

5. Therefore, humble yourselves, lest ye be overtaken with the darkness and confusion which is soon coming upon the earth, yea, and has already begun.

XIII. Hear the words of the Lord, ye people, all ye who have forsaken the Lord your God. How long will ye

walk in your own way? How long will ye provoke the Holy One, the Most High, with your sins? Your eyes are blind; your ears are deaf; your bodies are diseased: because ye are strangers to the Lord God. How long, how long will ye continue walking in the ways of darkness?

2. Hear the words of the Lord. Unless ye repent and turn unto the Lord your God, ye shall become as a running sore, and your wound shall lay open and shall not be healed: because, when I stretched forth My hand for deliverance, ye did not regard it, and, when I would have lifted you up upon the Rock, ye did reject your Lord.

3. Therefore, hear the words of the Lord, all ye who are rejecting, and do reject, My Father's words (I speak unto those who call themselves "Christian" and know Me not, as unto those who believe not in Me). The Lord thy God is alive. He rose again and ever pleads before His Father's throne. Soon, soon will His Spirit no longer strive with man.

4. Who art thou, oh man, that thou shouldest reject thy God? Who created thee, oh man? Who puts life and breath into thy body? Who made the heavens, the earth, sea, sky, sun, moon, stars, day and night, light and darkness, summer and winter? Didst thou do it, oh man? Answer My word.

5. Thou art silent before Me; thou art man and not God. Therefore, cease from thine own works and praise thy God who created all things, having wisdom, power and might in all His works.

6. As thou dost humble thyself before the Lord thy God, My Father's Spirit shall take possession of thee. Then shall many seek after God and find Him; and these shall experience the wonderful riches of the Kingdom of God. Then shall ye exalt the Lord your God and your praises shall ascend into the highest Heaven where sitteth the Father clothed in the Majesty and Glory of God, which was His before the foundation of the earth.

7. Many who read these words will reject them. Therefore, hear the words of the Lord God. He that rejecteth My Father's words shall be rejected by My Father in the presence

of God and of His holy angels. Multitudes who call themselves the children of God will spurn My word. Therefore, be warned, ye people; for unless ye hearken unto the words of the Lord your God, ye shall perish with those that go down into the pit. Your blood shall be upon your own head: for, in the day when My Father sent His word unto you, ye would not be warned.

XIV. As My children abide in Me and My words abide in them, their lives shall grow and the blessed fruits of the Righteousness of God become manifested.

2. Should not the children be like unto their father? So shall My children, who love and obey My word, become like unto their God. As they read My word and believe it, so shall they eat of the Living Bread. That Bread is God; therefore, they must become like unto their God Who feedeth them; for it is His life which He gives unto all who obey His voice.

3. Verily the word of the Lord feedeth the hungry soul; and is not His blessing upon all those who hunger and thirst after Righteousness? Few there be who desire the Righteousness of God; but unto these shall be given the unsearchable riches of Christ. "Evermore give us this Bread" shall be the desire of My children throughout all ages, which I do speak, and which I will continue to speak, so shall the Spirit of God enter their hearts, revealing the wonderful and glorious mysteries of the Kingdom of Heaven by the wisdom of God. As My faithful children feed upon Me, an eternal fountain of Living Water shall spring up within their spirits, filling them with joy unspeakable; their souls shall find satisfaction in the Kingdom of God; and the world will have no attraction for them, because they will have found the eternal attractive Power of the Son of God, and He shall be their joy and crown.

XV. Oh, My people, My people, why will ye die? The Lord your God loveth you with all His heart. Will ye altogether forsake your Lord? Pause a moment. Behold your Lord. Is it nothing to you, ye sin-stricken people, that your Lord should be rejected?

XVI. My children must follow their Lord very closely, having no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness: for they are living in the midst of a sinful and wicked generation that knoweth not the Lord, that remembereth not His great mercies and forgiveness, that rejecteth His mighty Power and that seeketh not after God.

2. Great shall be their sorrow when the day of grace has passed. Their cry shall sound through all the earth. They who delighted in the pleasures of the world will find them void of pleasure. They who revelled in sin and rejected the Lord God will find no pleasure in the things which once attracted them. Multitudes will bemoan the day in which they passed the Lord their God by.

3. The Spirit of the Living God hath pleaded with the children of men throughout all ages. Soon, soon the day of grace will close, and they who know not the Lord will have no fellowship with Him. As they have desired the pleasures and sins of the world (which are the devil's playground to keep the hearts of the people from finding the Lord), therein shall they continue to walk, who obey not My word neither My voice. Great shall be the tribulation which shall fall upon the ungodly, and few there be who will be able to stand firm for the Lord God.

4. Oh, My people, can ye not see? Will ye remain blind to the devices of the enemy? Remember how he deceived the woman in the garden of Eden, saying, "Hath God said?"; and causing her to sin and disobey her Lord. Will ye serve willingly him who can only bring horror, sin and death? Remember his end draweth very near. Will ye follow him into eternal death and anguish? Will ye be satisfied to gaze for an eternity upon the suffering which shall and must be the portion of those who reject the Lord God?

5. "Hath God said?" will the enemy whisper into the hearts of many who read these words. God hath said. God hath said; and woe be unto those who reject the words of the Lord God.

6. Oh, My people why do ye weary yourselves after vain desirings? The world has no satisfaction for the chil-

dren of God. Herein are known those who love and follow the Lord God, and those who but profess to follow Him, yet continually need the pleasures of the world.

7. My children, who know Me, have their desire, which is to accept their God in the Person of the Lord Jesus Christ. As they accept Him, the Power of the resurrected Christ shall feed their hearts, and to them shall be made known the mysteries of the Kingdom of God. Therefore, trust ye in the Lord. Come unto Me and ye shall find in Me all that ye can desire. My promises are sure. I am not likened unto one who promiseth a thing and performeth it not. I am the Lord God Omnipotent.

8. The Lord God is a great God: His works are infinite; His ways past finding out. He raiseth up and He casteth down; He bindeth fast and He setteth free. He is the Great God Omnipotent. Therefore, tremble all ye people who dwell upon the earth, tremble ye, tremble ye. The Lord, He is God; and with the breath of His lips will He slay the wicked.

XVII. Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of Salvation; behold, now is the day of grace. Where are they who cry unto Me, saying, "Oh, Lord, visit me with Thy Salvation"?

2. Knowest thou the Salvation of the Lord? Yea, it is holiness from the heart: and true holiness is the Righteousness of God, which is able to conquer all sin.

3. Many of My children fall short of what their Lord desires them to be. They soon forgot their Lord, Satan enters their hearts, and they become cold and indifferent to the things of God.

4. Many, yea multitudes, are starving spiritually; because, when they ask for Bread, oftentimes they are given stones. The Lord thy God desires all who seek to follow Him to be fed with Living Bread, and that Bread is the risen Son of God.

5. Therefore, all ye who read these words and who have found little or no satisfaction from the teachings of men, turn unto the word of God—which ye call the Scriptures—and read how the Lord Jesus Christ left His

Father's home in Glory and came to earth in the form of a little child; living a pure and holy life before all men, healing, teaching, upbraiding many because of their hardness of heart and unbelief, rejected of all; oft-times tempted by the devil, brought before councils, judges and rulers; openly condemned, spat upon, beaten with many stripes, made a gazing stock and a laughing stock unto many people; crowned with cruel thorns, nailed upon the cross, suffering agonies of tortures before the mocking crowd; giving up the Ghost to His Father, pierced in His side (thus fulfilling the prophecy of the Scripture); laid in a borrowed grave, after the appointed time rising again from the dead by the will of the Father; appearing to many of His disciples in different form (many amongst whom believed not); ascending unto heaven, and sitting down on the right hand of the Father; having been obedient unto Him; having given all things into His hands, that the Promise—"If I go away I will send the Promise of the Father"—might be fulfilled; which Promise is the Holy Ghost, given unto all who love and obey the commands of the Lord Jesus Christ; which commands are given unto Him from the Father, Who is the same yesterday, to-day, and forever.

XVIII. Hear the words of the Lord your God, all ye who desire to follow Me. Many of My children are living in a stationary position to-day, when they should be progressing in the Spirit. And why? Because they stand still at belief. Know ye not that it is not enough for you to believe? Ye must also be obedient unto your Lord, even as I was obedient unto My Father.

2. Therefore, all those who believe My word and obey it not shall not see the Kingdom of God, neither shall they enter it. Only unto those who obey My word and love and serve Me with all their hearts, shall the Promise of the Father be given.

3. The Holy Ghost is the operating Power of the Triune God, working in the hearts of the children of God, doing many mighty acts, and astonishing many people. The eyes of the spiritually blind shall be opened; the ears

of the spiritually deaf shall be unstopped; the tongues of the spiritually dumb shall be loosened; and the whole body, soul and spirit shall be quickened by the Power of the Holy Ghost. And, even as your members be restored by the same Power; that the Triune God may be glorified through the hearts and bodies of the children of God.

4. Therefore, thou that desirest to follow the Lord God, surrender thyself wholly unto Him, having no fear: for the Lord thy God loveth thee, and with tender compassion draweth thee unto Himself | But the wrath of God falleth upon the sinner who continueth in his sin, and upon those who reject and scorn His word and blaspheme His Holy Name.

XIX. The Lord thy God is the Lamb slain before the foundation of the earth. Behold, yea, behold His Face of spotless purity and tender love, His head, His hands, His feet, His side.

2. Remember how He trod the wine-press alone for thee, that thou mightest escape thy rightful punishment of an eternal death.

3. Remember His words which He spake unto His disciples when He walked this earth. Many erred, were weak and sinful; and He upbraided many for unbelief. He strengthened the weak, and many mighty acts He wrought through the mighty Power of God.

4. Remember that He changes not, but is always the same, yesterday, to-day, and for ever; ready to pardon the penitent, restore the backslider, heal the sick, cast out devils; ready to work even greater works than He wrought when He abode upon the earth.

5. Art thou willing to follow thy Lord? Then remember that they who follow the Lamb whithersoever He goeth must be willing to follow Him by the way of the Cross.

6. As thou dost follow thy Lord thou shalt have great joy and fellowship; for He will take up His abode within thee, and take of the things of God and reveal them unto thee. They who wholly surrender themselves unto Me and follow Me shall become vessels for Mine honour.

7. Oh that My children would hearken unto My voice. Oh that My people would cease from their own works and hearken unto the Lord their God. Oh that My people could behold the Lord their God as He pleads before the Father's throne of Grace.

8. Will ye persecute Him all the day long by your sins, your self-righteousness, your hypocrisy, your lukewarmness and indifference?

10. The Lord your God is alive, alive for evermore, and would do many mighty acts if ye would yield unto Him.

XX. Beware of deceivers who walk to and fro in sheep's clothing, bearing My Name; inwardly they are ravenous wolves, desiring the glory and praises of men, clothed in self-righteous robes. How beautiful they appear in the sight of men, but how grievous in the eyes of the Lord God.

2. Harken unto the words of the Lord, thou who dost profess to love Me. Where is thine obedience unto My commands? Pause a moment, thou who readeest the Scriptures; believest thou the word of God? Verily I say unto thee, Unless thou dost obey the commands of My word, thou shalt not enter the kingdom of God. The Lord thy God is a jealous God, and will not suffer thy coldness, thine indifference and hypocrisy forever. Thou art man and not God. Thou must be obedient unto the word of the Lord thy God, forsaking thine own way and following in the way which the Lord thy Saviour—even Jesus—purchased for thee by shedding His precious blood.

3. The day of Grace is almost past, the coming of the Lord draweth nigh, and ye are not saved. Ye worship Me with your lips but your hearts are closed. Ye know Me not, and your profession is an abomination unto the Lord God. He Who desireth thee to worship Him in spirit and in truth is against all who have a form of godliness and deny in their hearts and by their lives the wonderful power of God.

4. Behold, all ye workers of iniquity that read the words of the Lord your God, Who created you and gave you life; as ye have spurned My words which I have spoken unto you, so shall ye be spurned in the presence of

God and of His holy angels. Ye are become an abomination in My sight.

5. Repent ye evil doers, repent ye professing Christians and ye who worship Me with your lips but with your hearts work deceit; for I, the Lord, am against all who worship Me neither in spirit nor in truth. Have I not called you many times and ye have not hearkened unto Me? Have I not stretched forth My hand and no man regarded? Therefore, remember that your sins and your iniquities shall rise up against you in the day when ye are judged.

6. The time has drawn very near for the coming of the Lord. Who among the inhabitants of the world will stand, having no righteousness of their own, clad in the robes of Christ's Righteousness, waiting and ready to return with their Lord and Saviour; to behold—not through a glass darkly, but Face to face—the mysteries and the majesty of the kingdom of God, and to receive, according to their faith, the mansions prepared for them?

7. Many shall there be who will not partake of the marriage supper of the Lamb; many who call themselves the children of God will be outside the Kingdom; many shall say, Have we not done many mighty works in Thy Name? Have we not spoken in Thy Name?

8. Yea, I say unto you, Unless ye have the Power of God sweeping through you, ye have no life: for the Blood and the Spirit are Life.

9. The world to-day is full of people who speak in My Name, but who know Me not, see Me not, and hear Me not.

10. Hear the words of the Lord your God. I am the Lord God; and, behold, I am alive for evermore. Seek ye the Lord while He may be found: for, verily I say unto you, the day is soon coming when ye shall desire to serve Me and shall not be able. Read My word and obey it; and the joy and peace of God shall fill your hearts. The ye shall not fear though an army rise up against you; nor shall ye fear famine, pestilence, sword, sudden death or plague, which shall sweep multitudes off the earth: for the Lord has promised to keep His beloved.

11. Where is your love and trust, your faith and patience? Is not your

God—the Lord Jehovah—Alpha and Omega? Trust ye in the Lord. Seek My peace and My rest: for My Spirit shall sweep over your troubled souls, filling them with a great calm, as ye obey and follow Me.

XXI. As ye, My children, see the judgments of the Lord God poured out upon the earth, know that the coming of the Lord draweth nigh.

2. Awake ye sleepers, awake, awake.

3. Where will ye flee for refuge when ye see the plagues falling upon the earth? Think ye that ye will escape though ye sin willingly? Ye cannot stay the arm of your God. When sickness falls upon you ye cannot deliver yourselves. When famine sweeps through the earth, as I, the Lord, have declared it shall, ye will be helpless: for ye cannot by your own efforts make the barren land yield her increase, neither can ye cause the dried up river to flow. Therefore, remember ye are men and not God; and behold the Majesty of God: for all power is given unto Him from the Father by Whom all things were made.

4. These are the words that the Lord God speaketh concerning the peoples of the world to-day. Open thine ears and hear My Voice, open thine hear and accept My speech. Behold, I say unto thee, there be many who will read these words and obey them not; they shall receive the just reward of their sin, even as they who do believe and accept shall receive their reward—even righteousness, joy and peace in the Holy Ghost—the indwelling Power of the Son of the Most High God.

5. I say unto thee, Watch, My beloved, watch. Your Lord is soon coming with ten thousands of His saints. Your hearts shall rejoice as ye read the words of the Lord your God. The night of weeping is nearly spent, and the eternal light of the glorious Kingdom of your God and Saviour Jesus Christ is ready to be revealed. Gird up your loins; be ye clothed with the garment of Christ's Righteousness; that, when He shall come with the sound of the trumpet, ye may be found waiting and ready to meet your Lord—even the Bridegroom, the Son of the Living God.

6. As My children behold their Lord

in all the glory, majesty and power of God, their joy shall be full. They shall follow their beloved with eager footsteps; with unveiled eyes shall they behold the Kingdom of Heaven, and many shall rejoice with joy unspeakable. As the mysteries of the Kingdom become manifest, great shall be the praise and glory which shall ascend unto Him who is the One Eternal Spirit—even Jesus the Mediator.

7. Oh My people, My people, I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have called you; I have knocked long at your hearts' door; I have waited patiently for you to open unto Me. Will ye not come unto Me that ye may have Life and be called by My Name?

8. My children, My children, behold the sufferings of your Lord. Shall Gethsemane and Calvary be counted for nought?

9. Know, all ye who continue in sin, disobedience and indifference to My word, that ye are numbered with that company who before Pilate cried, away with Him!

10. See ye not the darkness that is sweeping over the whole earth? See ye not the shadows? Yea, the arms of the evil one are seeking to embrace you, that ye may be overcome of evil. Be not deceived.

11. Again I say unto you, Remember the days of Noah, when sin, shame, darkness, and confusion covered the earth. Would they be warned? No! Would they accept the word of God? No! See ye not that the world to-day is in deeper darkness through sin and unbelief? Having greater light they have the greater sin.

12. The hand of judgment is falling upon the earth to-day; but where are they who regard it? Few there be who seek after God; few who walk the narrow way which leadeth into the Kingdom of God.

XXII. Give ear and hear My words, all ye who obey not My words neither give ear unto My comandments. Are ye able to still the raging of the sea, or to still the wind when it ariseth? Ye have no power. Therefore, hear My words. Unless ye turn unto Me and obey My word ye shall become a prey unto the evil one.

2. Where is your holiness, your purity or your devotion?

3. Think ye that I delight in sacrifice, in worship of idols and of images of stone which ye have made with your hands, and to which ye bow down?

4. I am against all such idolatry.

5. Remember that the Lord your God is a jealous God, yea, I say unto you, a very jealous God.

6. Remember that there is no Mediator between man and God except Christ Jesus, Who is the propitiation for your sins. Remember that He is the Paschal Lamb slain before the foundation of the earth, and that He now liveth to make intercession for those who seek to love and serve God.

7. Oh, My children, My deluded ones who are held in bondage by the fear of man, who is less than nothing in My sight. Trust ye in the Lord your God, and read My word which shall bring light into your path.

9. Nothing can save you but the precious blood of Jesus Christ the Son of God, Who came as a little child that He might be an example unto all who follow Him.

10. Repentance, many prayers and tears will not avail for those who have departed this life: for, unless ye are clothed with the Righteousness of Christ when ye depart this life, nothing can avail for your spiritual benefit: for ye are swallowed up of death.

11. Remember that there is no Mediator and no Advocate but Jesus Christ the Son of God. Nothing that man can do will avail for you.

12. Therefore, all ye who are living in bondage—many ignorantly—hearken unto the words of God. Ye have sinned against the Lord your God in making images and statues and falling down before them. Above all ye have changed the word of God into a lie, and have put on high looks and proud stomachs and think ye shall gain an entrance into My Kingdom by your prayers, fastings and penances.

13. Therefore, hear the words of your God. There shall not enter into My Kingdom any who loveth and maketh a lie. Idolaters, whoremongers, sorcerers, unbelieving, or murderers—all these shall be cast out into outer darkness, where there shall be great

lamentation, weeping, wailing and gnashing of teeth.

XXIII. Awake, My people, awake, awake; cast forth your grave clothes which have bound you these many years, and come unto Me. Fear not the scorner neither the unbeliever.

2. Many will say, We have continued so long in our own way that we cannot easily follow another.

3. Awake. Return unto thy Lord quickly: for I say unto thee, Soon, yea, very soon, the strivings of My Spirit shall cease from among men.

4. Therefore, all people, nations and tongues, look ye unto Me and be ye saved—saved from sin, eternal damnation and destruction.

5. Ye people, who profess to love and serve Me, ye who appear beautiful in the eyes of men, doing many charitable and kindly deeds that men may speak well of you; how will it be when ye stand before My Father's throne? Thy profession will not save thee, neither thine alms. Only he who hath obeyed the will of God, who keepeth His commandments and who glorifieth God, shall rejoice in the everlasting peace and comfort of the Holy Ghost.

6. My people, My people, hearken unto the words of the Lord your God. Arise, arise, shake off your slothfulness and gird on the armour which shall bring you liberty—even that glorious privilege and relationship which enables all who love and obey Me to be called the sons of God.

7. The people of the world are asleep; they are dull of hearing; lethargy hath taken hold upon them; they have a form of godliness, and with their mouths they do worship Me while their hearts are far from Me. Few there be who know Me; few there be who can say with My servant of old, We knew in Whom we have believed, and are persuaded.

8. And why?

9. Because they have become lukewarm. They are neither cold nor hot; and, because they have tasted of the heavenly treasure and have spurned it, their punishment shall be the more terrible.

XXIV. What doth the Lord your God desire?

2. A people wholly yielded unto

Desire of God.

Him; a people whose desire is to know the Lord, hungering and thirsting after the Righteousness of God; a people with an open heart, desiring above all things the indwelling power of the Son of God; a people whose bodies are as clay, yielded unto God as temples for the Holy Ghost to work in—doing and revealing many mighty things—that they, who are not delivered from the bondage of sin, might know that the Promise of the Father has been fulfilled by the manifestation of the Power of God in the hearts and lives of the children of God.

3. Come unto Me, My people. Cease from following the traditions of men. Open your hearts wide that I, your Lord, may enter: for am I not to be desired before all men?

4. Am I not the Lord God Omnipotent? Was I not in the bosom of the Father before the foundation of the earth? Before it was, I was. When there was neither height nor depth, I was there; when the earth, the heavens, and the waters that are above the heavens were made, I was there. Yea, I rejoiced greatly in the works of My Father's hands, when He made the sun, the moon, the stars, day and night, winter and summer.

5. Man, thou art altogether gone out of the way of thy Lord. Should not thine heart seek after the Lord of Heaven, Who hath done such wondrous works?

6. The Lord Jesus Christ speaketh not unto the wise and learned of the earth but unto the lowliest of His servants. These are they who endure suffering and hardship cheerfully for their Lord. In the world they shall have tribulation, even as their Lord had; but they who love Me will not fear the thorny path as they follow on to know their Lord: for their joy will be in doing His will, and in declaring His word and His power.

7. Hear, My people, near the words of the Lord your God. Why stand ye afar off? Draw near, draw near and behold your God who hath given so much for you. Why seek ye the Living among the dead? for I am alive for evermore.

8. Open thine heart and obey My word, and I will come in and sup with thee and thou with Me; and the food

wherewith I shall feed thee will be the Resurrection Life of the Son of God.

11. I am the Lord, and, beside Me, there is none other. As thou openest thine heart unto Me, thou shalt know that thy Lord is alive, that He liveth, moveth and speaketh by prophecy, by vision, by voice and by tongues interpreted: for all this I will reveal unto My children who truly seek after Me for the glory of God, Who is the Eternal Spirit of the Father.

XXV. Except a man be born again, he cannot see the Kingdom of God, neither shall he enter it.

2. Where are they who are born again, not after the flesh—for the flesh profiteth nothing—but after the Spirit?

Where are they who have become the sons of God, and have access into their Father's home?

4. Ye must be born again, ye children of men; ye must be born again. Ye have neither joy nor peace because ye do not the will of God. Ye are the children of disobedience: call not yourselves the children of God.

5. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit he hath neither part nor lot in the Kingdom of Heaven: for he neither seeth it nor entereth it.

6. Multitudes will say, Have we not read these words many times from the Scripture? Yea, I say unto you, ye have read them, but ye believe them not, and ye obey them not. Therefore unless ye feel and hear and know the power of God, ye are not born again.

7. The wind bloweth wher it ariseth; thou hearest the sound thereof, but knowest not whence it cometh, nor whither it goeth: so is every one who is born of the Spirit.

8. Many will say, He speaketh not unto us: He knoweth our frame, and remembereth how weak we are, how prone to sin, how easily we are overcome. Are we not like unto our first parents, who sinned through weakness; and hath not sin reigned unto this day?

9. Therefore hear the words of the Lord, ye ignorant ones, ye careless ones, ye lukewarm Christians. Yea, sin left a curse upon the children of men; from the time when Satan en-

tered the garden of God sin brought death, yea, the seed of Adam first tasted of death. Afterwards came the law, given by God unto His people at Sinai; but the blood of bulls and goats, incense, many prayers, the temple and the tabernacle availed not for the sins of the people. Therefore God sent forth from the glory of heaven His only begotten Son, allowing Him to become sinful flesh that they who follow Him might become the children of God.

10. Therefore, seeing that the Blood of Jesus Christ opened the way into the Kingdom of heaven—there being finished His Father's work, rising and ascending into the highest heaven—be not ignorant, all ye whose desire is after God, but forsake the world, the sins which separate thee from God, and the vicious pleasures which keep thy thoughts occupied oftentimes with thine temporal. Seek by prayer more confidence in God, even though thou art chastened. Resist all thy sins and temptations which beset thee by reading My word and My truth causes the tempter to flee. Remember that My word and My truth remain forever. Deny thyself, take up thy cross and follow Me.

XXVI. They who follow Me must be prepared to follow the way their Lord went—even the thorny path to Gethsemane and Calvary. Thy walk shall become one of sweet fellowship, and the grace of God shall take thee through many temptations triumphant. The grace which I will adorn thee with shall keep thee humble, and enable thee to despise thyself and become nothing, that thou mayest see the greatness of thy God and glorify Him.

2. My children, My children, the Lord your God desireth you, yea, His heart goeth out unto you: for He loveth you with an everlasting love. Prepare, prepare—make ready a large upper room—and I will come and meet with you and ye with Me. As ye come unto Me ye shall be made strong; but, only as ye abide in Me shall ye find freedom from sin. Remember that I know the secret thoughts of your hearts.

3. Too often being tempted by enemy of your souls, ye turn aside

from following your Lord. My children must remain steadfast if they seek their Father's home in glory.

4. Follow closely, and let not thine heart fail thee, neither let it be afraid: because thou must pass through many trials and temptations before thou canst enter the Kingdom. Great shall be thy peace as thou obeyest thy Lord and thou shalt know of a surety that the Kingdom of God is joy and peace in the Holy Ghost.

5. The children of obedience shall obtain a glorious entrance into My Kingdom: for God shall take up His abode in their hearts and fill them with joy and peace in believing.

6. Many stumble among you and many fall. Yea, thou dost confess to-day thy sins and to-morrow thou dost again sin against Me. Oh, man, acknowledge thy frailty: for thou art dust and hast no might, thou art but a vapour; to-day thou art and to-morrow thou art not.

7. Therefore, seeing thou canst not order thy goings, seek ye after God: for He alone is Thine everlasting Salvation. Seek ye the Lord whilst He may be found.

XXVII. The coming of the Lord draweth nigh; yea, His coming is near at hand.

2. Who among men will be found worthy?

3. Shall the Son of man find faith when He cometh?

4. Wholly offer thyself unto Me, and I will feed thee with the Bread of Heaven and the Water of Life. Come ye and drink.

5. My word is still the same: for the Lord changeth not.

6. Where is thy peace? Behold the nations of the earth. What saith the Lord God? Yea, I will bring down all those who are lifted up. Thy peace cometh only through Jesus Christ thy Lord.

7. Therefore, seek after God, and He shall fill thine heart with peace. My Presence shall abide in and with thee, and thou shalt find rest in obeying My word.

8. The coming of the Lord is near.

9. Be silent before thy God and behold the kingdoms of the earth. What seest thou? Pleasures heaped up, and multitudes lusting only for this world's joys.

10. Multitudes are passing every moment out of this life. Where? Many into eternal darkness! For as they have lived without God, desiring only the sins and pleasures of life, their opportunity has passed.

11. They who seek not the Lord shall not find Him on leaving this life: for where their treasure is, there will their heart be also. Having eyes they see not, and having ears they hear not. An impassable gulf shall separate them from the children of God.

12. Seek ye the Lord while He may be found: for He loveth thee with an everlasting love, and hath He not created thee for His glory and praise?

13. Will ye not come unto Him that ye may have life, yea, the eternal life of God, Who is the great Eternal Word?

XXVIII. My people, thus saith your God, In the world ye shall have tribulation; but be of good cheer, the Son of God hath overcome the wicked one, who is prince of this world.

2. My people, let not sorrow overcome you: for they who follow Me will become despised, even as their Lord was and is by many who call themselves the children of God. Was I not an alien unto My mother's children, rejected by all?

3. My children must be willing to take up their cross and follow their Lord. Ofttimes their way will be thorny: so it was for their Lord. Ofttimes they will stumble. Ofttimes they will be tempted: was their Lord. Persecuted, despised and forsaken was the Lord thy God: and all who follow Him must be willing to suffer with Him and for Him.

4. Remember that thy God is the Eternal Spirit, incomprehensible, full of majesty and power, Who doeth great and terrible things, Whose ways are unsearchable.

5. Therefore, seeing the greatness of God, Whose ways are past finding out, Who knoweth thy secret thoughts and the imaginations of thine heart, humble thyself before Him, that He may forgive thee thine iniquities, that thou mayest become a child of God.

XXIX. Ye must be born again—not after the flesh, but after the Spirit—that the Lord thy God may find

access into His temple, which He hath purchased for His rightful possession, that the Father may be glorified in the Son through the children of God.

2. Repent, repent, repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand and the coming of the Lord draweth nigh.

3. Are ye ready to be caught up with the children of God at His coming?

4. Ye must repent, ye must repent; for with what spirit ye leave this world, the same shall follow thee into the next.

6. They who love and obey My words become the sons of God and are heirs of Salvation, and theirs is the Spirit of the only begotten Son of God.

6. Hearken unto the words of the Lord, all ye people who seek the pleasures of the world, all ye who haunt the byways and highways. Ye seek pleasure in that which is not profitable for your souls' welfare.

8. Why seek ye after that which is but transitory. It giveth thee pleasure but for a moment, and ofttimes thine heart is filled with remorse. In thy sins remember the word of the Lord thy God, "He who loveth this word, the love of the Father is not in him."

The world is full of evil, and unless My children follow hard after their Lord they will fall away: for the devil hath many devices with which to lure them away.

10. Therefore, be steadfast, seek after God and His pleasure, and He will not fail thee: for His word abideth forever.

1. Behold, the world passes away, but the word of the Lord standeth sure.

12. Therefore, all ye nations who shall read these words, read them not as idle tales: for they are life and truth. In the day of the Lord ye shall be without excuse if ye spurn My Father's word: for man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word which proceedeth forth from the mouth of God. For the Lord is the same yesterday, to-day and forever, and He who gave the Law unto Moses and spake by prophecy unto Elijah is the same God who speaketh unto His children to-day.

13. They who accept My words in John 5:2 to 20, I saw the Lord shall be accepted by My Father in Jesus, His hair white and shining, heaven, and they who reject My standing before me. Placing His words shall be rejected by My Father lovely hands upon my head, He said: in heaven.

14. They who love Me will seek to follow Me; and they who follow Me shall know their Lord. As they follow Me they shall hear the words of the Lord which He will speak unto many of His children: for His word is life.

15. Few there be who desire the Lord God: but these shall be abundantly blessed: for they shall experience that the Lord Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, to-day and forever.

16. Thus endeth the words of this prophecy, which the Lord Jesus Christ hath revealed unto His servant by the seeing of the eye and the hearing of the ear. AMEN.

GOD'S MESSAGE TO THE NATIONS

INTRODUCTION

(God's Message to the Nations)

A prophecy given in a vision to one of God's Vessels* while in trance (comp. Peter in Acts 10:9-11, and Paul in Acts 22:17-18). Each trance commenced during a prayer meeting at a private house in England, the first three being after a baptismal service. The vision was divided into four separate parts, and each part was written out immediately each trance was over. The vision lasted from April 3rd to 19th, and during that time God's Vessel was unable to eat any food (comp. Matt. 4:1, 2, where the Lord Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness and fasted forty days). Chapter III was written out at 4:30 in the morning after praying alone all night. It was dark, but two angels appeared in the room, which, having no other light, was lit up by their presence (Acts 12:7). They disappeared immediately the writing was finished. It was prophesied beforehand that God's Vessel was going to have a vision lasting several days, and numbers of people, including a doctor, witnessed this demonstration of the power of God (Rom. 1:16; 15:13,19; 1 Cor. 1:18, 24; 2:4, 5; 4:19).

*God has shown us that He approves of the names of His Vessels being hidden. Isaiah 42:8, and Acts 7:51-53 will explain the reasons.—P. St. G. K.

I. A vision in trance lasting 32¾ hours, from 8:45 P. M., April 3rd, to 5:30 A. M., April 5th, 1919.

2. After seeing the scene described

3. "My child, I will give thee power to lay hands upon whomsoever I command thee, and they shall be healed, also speak unto all my children who hear My Voice and obey Me. In my Father's Name ye shall do this, and cast out devils, and speak in tongues, and prophesy, and I will reveal the Father's glory.

4. "For many are being led astray by those who call themselves the children of God. I know them not; yea, I am against them, for they speak My Word unto the people, but will not believe, because they have not the love of God in their hearts, neither the Spirit nor the Power of God.

5. "Yea, they are not going My Way, which I have set before them, but their own way. They have no life, for life is Spirit. Their works are dead, and souls are starving for food which they think they have yet have not. I cannot help them, for they obey not My word, which they see and hear and know."

6. "For if they were obedient, they would repent from their hearts of all their sins, and would call unto Me, and I would give them new hearts. They would follow Me through the waters of baptism, and would receive of My Spirit. But they will not: therefore, I know them not.

7. "They shall know that I am with My people who are obedient to My Word."

8. Then I saw the Lord Jesus standing in the heavens, and saying with a loud voice:—

9. "Behold the time draweth nigh, in which all men shall stand before God to be judged according to their works."

10. I could see great multitudes of people, quite indifferent to the Lord, intoxicated with the sins and pleasures of this world. The Lord caught me up to His side and said unto me:—

11. "Prophecy unto these people, saying: Thus saith the Lord God: I have called thee from the rising up of the sun unto the going down of the same. I am against thee, and will pour out My fury upon thee, for ye will not hearken unto Me.

12. "I have borne thy ways, but My Spirit shall not always strive with man.

13. "I, the Lord God, will cause a sword to come upon thee, and there shall be a great slaughter. Those who seek to escape the slaughter shall perish in the famine which I will cause to come upon thee. The faces of all who will not obey My Word shall become as charred wood, and ye shall look for food and shall not find it; for when I would have fed thee with the Living Bread and with the Water of life, ye would not. Thy cattle also shall die.

14. "Those who think to escape the famine shall be taken by a pestilence of running sores, boils and grievous complaints, which shall come upon thee and upon thy cattle; for men have followed their own way and have served Satan.

15. "I will cause My Words to be sent to the Isles, north and south, east and west. All shall hear and be astonished.

16. I have warned all men in My Word. Repent quickly; forsake thine own way; turn unto Me; and I will give thee a new heart, wherein is no evil thought or desire. Ye shall be born of My Spirit, become the sons of God—willing and obedient—and be used as flames of fire."

17. Then I saw the same vision I had seen on 27th October, 1917, including the crucifixion, the trumpet call, and the living and dead in Christ rising into the air to meet the Lord Jesus. Again He stood before me, holding out the robe I had seen before. Then He said:—

18. "This robe is My Righteousness, which I give unto My children who are faithful unto Me, and which shall be given unto thee."

19. In His hand I saw the crown which I had seen before. This time there were some jewels in it, but there were also spaces for more jewels. Then He spake again and said:—

20. "Be faithful in all I have said unto thee and shewn thee in vision. Many shall hear and be glad and turn unto Me. Multitudes shall harden their hearts and speak evil of thee, but be thou faithful unto Me, and I will give thee the crown of Life."

TO THE NATIONS

21. Then I saw a long narrow path, which I had seen in a vision on January 13th, 1918. Last time I had seen no one upon the path, but now I saw many walking along it towards the Lord. At the end of the path I saw the cross, the robe and the crown; and above them the Lord Jesus, Who said:—

22. "These are those who are obedient to My Word, and go My Way. They shall receive their reward."

23. Among these people I saw Chinese, Japanese, Indians, Turks, Russians and many other nationalities. Again the Lord spoke, saying:—

24. "I will cause 'Signs and Wonders' to teach these people, for they shall see therein that My Word is sure, and that I have not changed. I will give great blessings unto those who read this book, for therein shall they find many wonderful works, and they will return unto My Word which they have rejected. They will also know that I am God, and that I do these mighty works."

I was carried away into a beautiful garden where there was perfect peace, and for a long time rested there in a wonderful light and was filled with joy. The Lord Jesus stood before me once again, and said:—

26. "Be faithful unto Me, for I will cause thee to be a sign, a wonder and an astonishment to many people."

II. A vision in trance lasting 24½ hours, from 9:40 P. M. April 5th, to 10:10 P. M., April 6th, 1919.

2. I found myself in the same beautiful garden as before. A river of clear water was running gently by, and I remained there a long time and was filled with joy and peace in the Holy Spirit. Then a beautiful angel came to me, saying:—

3. "Get thee up quickly, for the Lord will speak unto thee yet again."

4. I followed the angel and lighted upon a grassy mound and saw the Lord Jesus clothed in a long, blood-dyed robe. In His hands and feet and head I could see the wounds which He had received for me. With a very loud voice, He said:—

5. "I will speak unto the nations yet again, that they may turn unto Me; for behold My coming draweth nigh

and ye believe Me not. Ye shall not know the day nor the hour.

6. "Have I not sent **My prophets** at all times and prophesied through them? But ye will not be warned, for ye are a rebellious people, children of the devil, unclean, hypocrites, filled with the pleasures of this world, whose God is Satan. Yet ye profess to follow Me!

7. "I am against thee: I am burning with fury: for ye go not **My Way**, but your own way. **My Way** is the humble way, the narrow way; but ye seek the broad way wherein ye can riot.

8. "**Ye have no peace, for there is no peace except in Me.** Turn, turn, for I am a jealous God, and will not bear thine abomination forever. Ye know Me not, for ye have not been emptied of your sins. I have called thee but ye have not called unto Me; for ye serve man rather than God. Think not to yourselves that ye shall escape or wait yet a little longer.

9. "In the day of **My fury** ye shall know that I am the Lord, and that beside Me there is none other.

10. "Ye will not believe **My Word** but have made gods unto yourselves and receive glory of them. Therefore I am against thee.

11. **For I the Lord, seek a people who love Me with all their hearts, and who are obedient unto all My commands. I will give unto them My Spirit, and they shall not be blinded by man's wisdom, but shall be filled with the Power of God, and He shall teach them.**

12. "For man has set himself up against Me, and hath enlarged the borders of his garments, and hath put on a high look and a proud stomach.

13. "Did I not say unto thee that the world seeth Me not? Therefore, I am against them.

14. "Turn unto Me while I may be found, and I will give unto thee **My Spirit**, and ye shall be an astonishment for in the time of **My wrath** I will be thy safeguard, and will hide thee for a little while until **My swift fury** shall have swept over the whole earth.

15. **For I am the Lord. I have poured out My Spirit and would have done many mighty acts, but ye would not let Me in. Open, and I will come in and feed thee with Myself, and ye**

shall sing praises unto Me, and know of a surety that **My spirit dwelleth within and doeth the mighty works.**

16. "Many shall hear **My Words** and rejoice, but there are those who are a deluded people who will not obey **My Voice.** Nevertheless ye shall know in that day that is coming that **I have pleaded with thee through an ignorant vessel, that ye might know that it is not the wise nor the mighty, but the children of obedience through whom I manifest My Father's Power.**

17. "**My coming** shall be as a fierce fire, and all that are set up shall be brought low, for thou art altogether become vanity.

18. "Have I not been very gracious unto thee? Remember **My mercies** and turn unto Me while there is time."

19. I saw a great multitude of people of many nationalities. Amongst them were Egyptians, Spaniards, Turks, Russians, Italians, Japanese, Jews, Chinese, Indians and many French. The Lord Jesus said:—

20. "Speak unto these people, and tell them how **I love them, how I died for them, how I rose again, and how I live and intercede for them.**"

21. The Lord touched me and I was able to speak to each group in their own language. The Italians and the Chinese were the most responsive; for they praised God, and I joined in their praises, and say that He was very pleased. Then He said:—

22. "Be filled with **My Spirit**, for He doeth the works, and I will give thee power to do many mighty acts."

23. Again I saw a mixed multitude of these same people, and heard the Lord speak unto them, saying:—

24. "Thus saith the Lord God: Turn unto Me, for ye are blinded. Ye worship ye know not what, for ye have not **My Spirit.** Within ye are filled with abominations. Get ye emptied lest I come upon you and find you wanting."

25. "For behold, I will show unto all nations that **My Word is truth.**

26. Ye have rejected **My Word**, for ye say, Thus saith the Lord, and believe not. **Ye question My Word and for your own opinions.** Near destruction is coming upon the whole earth, for ye say and do not.

27. "**Call unto Me, for ye cannot come any other way: for there is no**

other mediator than I, who paid the price of thy sins, and I alone can save thee.

28. "Offer unto Me the sacrifice of thyself, and I will bless thee, and ye shall be a blessing."

29. Again I saw the Lord in the blood-dyed garments, and with a loud voice He said:—

30. "Awake! Repent ye nations quickly. For I say unto thee yet again that ye are an abomination in My sight. Ye have no righteousness and no depth. Repent quickly and turn unto Me, for if ye reject My words ye shall be cast out of My Presence forever."

31.. The vision changed again, and I saw four angels wearing golden girdles, who were very beautiful, and whose heads shone like gold. Two of the angels carried a scroll between the four corners of heaven, and the scroll was unrolled and stretched right across the heavens between the first two. Then I saw the Lord Jesus cast out over the earth a large net into which were gathered all the people of the earth. The four angels caught hold of the four corners of the net, each using his free hand. The two angels who carried sickles in their other hands began to separate the wicked from the righteous, sweeping them out of the net into an abyss, from which I heard sounds of great lamentation. The other two angels held the roll between them in their other hands, and read therefrom the names of the righteous, who, as their names were called out, were caught up to the Lord Jesus above them. Then He spoke, saying:

32. "I have spoken unto the nations, for they will not go My Way. There are many who shall hear My Word and be glad. Great multitudes will not hearken unto Me, but I have spoken, and ye shall know in that day that I am the Lord."

III. A vision in trance lasting 26 hours and 20 minutes, from 8:20 P. M. April 7th to 10:40 P. M. April 8th, 1919.

2. I found myself in the same beautiful garden as before, and saw the same beautiful angel, who stood before me and said:—

3. "Arise, for the Lord, even Jesus,

will speak through thee again, and what He sheweth thee and saith unto thee shall be for all people."

4. The angel lifted me up upon my feet and I went through space at a terrific rate, stood in the heavens and saw the Lord Jesus dressed in the blood-dyed raiment. His face was very stern, and below Him were millions of people who all appeared to be in an attitude of attention, as though they knew that He was there. Then He spoke to me, saying:

5. "These are the visions of God given unto thee from Jesus Christ, His Son, and He will show thee His truth, His love and justice."

6. I heard a rushing sound as of a great whirlwind, and felt it envelop me. Then the Lord cried with a loud voice, saying unto me:

7. "I send thee unto the people of many nations, for they have transgressed against Me; and thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the Lord God, Whether they hear My Word or reject, they shall know that I have sent My Spirit among them to warn them by My prophet, for these are the latter days."

8. "Thou shalt speak unto them My Words. Man hath hitherto spoken his words, but now I will speak unto these abominable people. Fear not."

9. I had a book placed in my hands, but did not see who gave it to me. In the book I saw written:—

10. "Thus saith the Lord God: I have spoken unto thee these many times, and ye will not hearken unto Me, for ye are a wayward people full of uncleanness. I am against thee, and My fury will I shortly pour out upon thee, for ye have hearts that are full of wickedness and ye pass Me by and heed me not. Think ye that I will bear thy sinfulness forever?"

11. "Behold, I even I Whom ye reject, will pour out My fury upon thee. Mine Eyes shall not spare, for in that day ye shall remember that I spake unto thee."

12. "Ye have set yourselves on high, and ye shall be brought low. Yea, ye shall be as ashes under the feet of My saints; for when I would have poured out My Spirit upon you, ye would not hearken unto Me."

13. "Ye are blind, ye are blind, ye know not what to do. I will bring de-

struction upon thee, and ye shall seek shall say, We must not obey these for peace, but find none. Words, for the Lord hath said them

14. Ye shall cry unto the shepherds, not; for He would not speak thus unto us, for He loves His people and will not deal thus with us.

neither obeyed My voice nor My word. 25. Behold, verily I say unto thee I am against the shepherds, for they that these are My Words and that say and do not. Wherein have they they are truth, for the seal of My obeyed My Word? Wherewith have blood is put thereon, and no man can they fed My sheeep? Not with My escape My fury when My judgments words, but with man's words! are upon the earth.

15. "Yea, those who obey My Word 26. "Have I not spoken unto thee shall receive their rewards, for it is by My prophets of old, and was not hard to obey. My Word fulfilled? If I speak unto thee through a weaker vessel, shall not My Word be true?"

16. "But ye are a disobedient people, and I must bring My judgments upon thee, for without these ye cannot learn righteousness. 27. "Ye obey men of understanding, and say among yourselves that these are they who shall rule over us and teach us; but I say unto thee that they of no understanding shall teach thee, that ye may know that I, the Lord, speak unto thee."

17. "The vision which I have given thee is for a sign, a wonder and an astonishment; for ye shall say among yourselves, Hath God's mercy changed from among us? Have we altogether lost our favour with God? Will He not remember us in the day of His wrath? Shall we not continue a little longer in our own way? And ye shall remember My words which I spake unto thee. 28. Then I heard the sound of a great battle, and looking downwards I could see men and women falling dead, slaying and being slain. I cried unto the Lord, saying:—

18. "Yea, ye have lifted yourselves yet a little longer, for this is a great up against Me. Woe, woe, be unto slaughter. But the Lord answered me.—

19. "Come unto Me while I may be 29. "Remember My Word which I found, and ye shall find rest and quietness, for I have loved thee. Yea, I spake unto thee." Then I saw millions of people living their ordinary lives, but soon I heard a voice saying:—

30. "The time is come, for these people will not obey My Word." 31. I saw the people looking very troubled for in the fields there was nothing but barrenness. The cattle and the people were dying for lack of food, and wild beasts were tearing them to pieces and devouring them. The faces of the people were like charred wood, and they cried unto God:—

20. The vision changed and I saw a great company of people of all nationalities. The Lord said:— 32. "Lord have mercy upon us, Christ have mercy upon us, for we have sinned."

21. "Speak unto these people and say, Thus saith the Lord: Repent ye; put away from thee thine idols which thou hast made, for they are not gods. For I only am God, and beside Me there is none other. But I heard a voice saying unto me: 33. "Remember My Word, for these are they who have rejected Me, therefore they must learn righteousness."

22. "Call unto Me with all thine heart, that I may hear thy cry and be merciful unto thee. 34. Again I saw the multitude of people and great troubles came upon them, including sores, boils and many disease. I saw wild beasts come upon the people and eat them up. I also

23. "Thou must run the way of My commandments and not man's way. I am very wrathful, for man has changed My Word into his word, and hath added unto it comforting words that My people should be deceived. 24. Watch ye always and pray, and I will teach thee. Many among thee

saw serpents biting the people and causing them to die, and there was great lamentation. Again they cried unto God:—

36. "Lord have mercy upon us, Christ have mercy upon us, for we have sinned."

37. I thought my heart would break, but I was powerless to speak. I heard a great thundering, and then a loud voice saying:—

38. "This is to show thee that **My Word is true, which ye have rejected and which men will not obey.** Nevertheless, I the Lord have shown it unto thee.

39. "Yea, I love thee. Yea, I mourn over thee as a mother over her son. Come ye unto Me, for I will teach thee, and ye shall be My people.

40. "For thou seest that **these are the days in which the Son of Man shall come.** They shall be as the days of Noah. Were they not drunken with the sins and the pleasures of the world as ye see them now?

40. "Turn unto Me, that ye may be found in My Spirit when I pour out My Father's judgments up the earth, for ye know not th day nor the hour when the Son of Man shall come.

42. "Therefore ye must be obedient, else how canst thou be ready at My coming?"

IV. A vision in trance lasting 14 hours 25 minutes, from 2:40 P. M. April 10th, 1919.

2. I saw the life of Jesus Christ from His babyhood to His ascension. Then I saw a beautiful white cloud and the Lord Jesus standing upon it with His hands outstretched, saying as in Mark 16:15-18:—

3. "Go ye into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe: in My Name they shall cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents, and if they drink any deadly thing it shall not hurt them. They shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover."

4. I saw those people, who had been standing under the cloud while the Lord was talking to them, go out into the streets and begin to preach to the people. They told them to **believe in**

the Lord Jesus Christ with all their hearts, to repent, and to be baptized; that then they should be **saved and receive power** from Him to cast out devils, to speak in new tongues, to prophesy, to take up serpents, to lay hands on the sick for their recovery, and that if they drank any deadly thing it should not hurt them.

5. Then I saw a river with high banks, and **many people were baptized in this river**, just as they were, in their clothes. Then I saw a room with a company of people in it; some of them I had seen beneath the Lord when He spoke to them from the cloud while others were their converts whom I had seen baptized. All were praying at once, independently, and calling to the Lord to pour out His Spirit upon them.

6. Then suddenly I heard and felt a great wind, and immediately I saw a sheet of fire, which divided into tongues of flame, each about a yard long, and lighted upon the head of each person. Immediately the fire fell they began to praise God in different languages (Acts 2:4, 15-18), and I with them. Then all appeared to be very happy and very excited, and they staggered about the room, filled with the **Holy Ghost**, praising the Lord simultaneously, yet independently.

7. Then I saw the Lord Jesus standing in the heavens, and a great multitude of people of all nations appeared on the earth below Him. In a very loud voice, He said:—

8. "I have called unto thee and ye would not answer Me. I have poured out My Spirit upon thee and ye will not receive, therefore I know thee not. Turn unto Me while I may be found, for My coming draweth nigh."

GOD'S REVELATION TO HIS PEOPLE PART I.

I. In a vision of 22¼ hours' duration, on December 26th-27th, 1919, I one of God's hidden vessels, beheld a great number of churches and halls of various denominations and sects. I saw the congregations entering these buildings, and then the doors were closed. **Outside** I beheld the Lord Jesus Christ, clothed in a red garment.

2. He went up to each of the build-

ings, and knocked upon the closed doors, but **not one of them answered His knock!**

3. Turning away from them, with a very sad look upon His face, He looked at me and said:—

4. "I have knocked, but none have opened unto **Me!** I have called, but none will hear **My Voice!** Soon My knocking will cease, and the offer of My Love will be withdrawn. I gave **My Life** to ransom these people, yet I am kept **outside** the door!

5. "Soon, I, the Lord, will pour out My Wrath and Vengeance upon these unbelieving people.

6. "These are they that have a form of Godliness, but **deny My Power.** They know nothing of My Love. I send forth My Word unto them, but they will not receive it. Thy preference of their own righteousness to the Righteousness I would give unto them, if they heard My Word. They are called by My Name, but they have never known Me, nor the Power which the Father hath given unto Me.

7. "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. They will not walk in My Way, nor believe My Truth, and accept My Life, which I so freely gave for them. Therefore I have no pleasure in them.

9. "They will not come unto Me that they may obtain **Life;** and Life is not to be found in any other but Me. Oh that these people would only turn unto Me, ere I have forever passed by.

10. "**Awake!** awake! Oh ye sleeping ones, and rouse yourselves out of the slumber which the enemy of your souls has brought upon you.

11. "Why will ye die? Why will ye sin on, and refuse Mercy and Peace, and run yourselves into eternal death and damnation?

12. "Why will ye continue spiritually dead? Dead in your guilt, ignorance, unbelief and hardness of heart: dead unto God.

13. "Is there no such thing as **communion with God,** and with your Lord? Why do ye continue deaf to all this?

14. "Why will ye refuse the Author of Life? Why will ye reject and refuse the Way of Life, the good Way that will lead you to Me, and the path I have made known?

15. "Ye that have the Word of God in your hands and in your mouths, oh, that ye would believe My Word.

16. "I am still knocking, standing, and waiting at your door; My Spirit is still striving with you. Are ye resolved that your Redeemer shall have no more glory in your Salvation? Are ye resolved that your Redeemer shall have no more honour or satisfaction in you, or praise from you?

17. "Awake! Awake from your slumber, and turn to Me, for I have given **My Love, My Life, My all for you!**

18. "Are the sufferings of Gethsemane and the Cross to be of no effect to you? Are the thorns and the nails nothing to you?

19. "Oh, ye people, give unto Me your hearts. Not the outward man only, not the body only, not thine ear only, not thy tongue only, not thy head only, but **thine heart.** Not in appearance, but in **reality;** not in part, but the whole.

20. "He that giveth his heart to Me giveth Me all things. All outward performances without the heart will not be accepted by My Father.

21. "Oh, ye people, why will ye be satisfied with doing your own works? Why will ye not turn unto **Me,** ere the call of love will cease?

22. "Have I not sent My servants unto you? Have ye not My Word therefor? Ye are inexcusable, in your neglect of your God.

23. "Soon, yea, very soon, My wrath shall be executed eternally.

24. "Though I, Jesus, am the mediator between man and God, there will be no mediator appointed to reconcile you, when ye have fully and finally resisted and rejected the grace I now offer unto you.

25. "How vain all your refuges and hopes, to avoid My Wrath and Vengeance, will be in that dreadful day.

26. "Ye will call upon the rocks and mountains to hide you from the Eyes of the Lord! Rocks and mountains—though places of secrecy and concealment—cannot hide you from the Eyes of your God.

27. "Do not imagine that God is all Love and Mercy. Yea, My mercy is now offered unto you; but ye will not accept it.

28. "Consider your ways, the danger you are in, and the need you have

of Me, Jesus, to be your Saviour. Fly to the Rock which is higher than you.

29. "Consider then what is behind you; the devil as a roaring lion, the curse of the broken law, and the wrath of God! And there is Salvation in no other. Oh, then, come unto Me, ere ye lose your souls forever.

30. "Soon this earth will be overcome by much sorrow, and pestilence, and famine. **Soon, I Jesus, will come for My Own faithful ones.** Few though they be, they shall soon pass away from their persecution, and shall enter into the joys of their Lord.

31. "Ah, hearken unto My Word, ye faithless and unbelieving ones. Why will ye despise My Word? If ye will not turn unto Me, ye shall perish through your disobedience and heart hardness. I am the Lord, Jehovah; I will be exalted on the earth, for My coming draweth nigh.

32. Then I saw the doors of the churches and mission halls open again, and the congregations came out. Nearly all were well dressed, and each carried a book of some kind.

33. A few, however, looked very anxious, and did not seem to know which way to go. Again I heard the Lord calling in a loud voice. "Come unto Me, come unto Me."

34. These few fell at His feet and I saw their garments change into beautiful white robes, and I heard the Lord say, "Now are ye clean through the Word, which I have spoken unto you."

35. Then He gave them commands to go forth in His Name and preach the Word to all the World; yet He told them to be separate from the world, saying:—

36. "Be ye not unequally yoked with unbelievers; for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what agreement hath the temple of the **Living God with idols?** For God hath said, I will walk in them, I will be their God, and they shall be My people."

37. "Come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord."

II. On the 26th of December, 1919, while I another of God's hidden vessels, was praying, the Lord Jesus Christ appeared to me, wearing a purple robe and a crown of thorns

upon His brow. Speaking to me, He said:—

2. "My child, I will reveal unto thee the truth of the Word of God. **Come ye out and be separate,** and I will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be My sons and daughters."

3. I saw hundreds of churches and other places of worship, into which the Lord Jesus entered and said:—
"Depart from Me, for I know you not."

4. What saith the Lord unto the Shepherds of the World to-day?

5. Have I not judged the Shepherds of Israel in My Word, because they did not feed My sheep? I change not! The Words which I spoke unto them I speak unto you; for I, the Lord, am the same yesterday, to-day, and forever.

6. I am the Word, but ye will not hearken unto Me! Neither will ye obey Me!

7. Have I not said in My Word, "Unless a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter the Kingdom of God?"

8. "Ye Shepherds: Do ye believe My Word—the Word which ye call the Bible?

9. Ye have not been born again! or ye would understand the mysteries of God; ye would be fed with spiritual food, even the very Life of God; and would feed My wayward children with Manna from Heaven.

10. But ye feed them with your own words! soothing words! comfortable words! flattering words! lying words! smooth words!

11. Know ye not, ye drowsy shepherds, that Satan is within you? I speak to you in plainness of speech, your words and your wisdom are as dung in My sight.

12. I, the Lord, will speak unto you yet again. Hear ye the Word of the Lord.

13. Ye scribes and pharisees! Hypocrites! **Ye shut up the Kingdom of God against your flocks!** Ye know the Way, but ye will not be obedient to My Word! Ye enter not in, for ye are not born again!

1. Ye have an entrance of your own invention into a Kingdom, but it is not My Kingdom! The Kingdom of Heaven is open to every man who is obedient to all My commands, and

who trembleth at My Word.

15. Ye **Shepherds**, by Me if any man shall enter in, he shall find **pastures**. But ye teach them not My Way; ye see not to it that My sheep are well fed. I speak through My children, and if ye would but hearken unto them ye would be fed abundantly, and signs and wonders should be done in My Name, even as I have promised in My Word.

16. Ye **Shepherds**, ye must see, as ye read these Words, that **ye are not saved!** for where are the signs which I said should follow **My work?** I say unto you, Where are they?

17. Ye **Shepherds**, doth it not humble you, that I, the Lord, should have to speak thus unto you? Ye do not love the flock, or ye would feed them, and not leave them hungry, cold, weary and sick! My sheep are dying on every side; not for want of pasture, for I have provided that; but because ye will not teach them My Word!

18. New Theology, Theosophy, Christian Science, Spiritualism, and many false doctrines are taking the place of **My Word to-day!**

19. Where are the **Shepherds** who can stand before Me, and say they have been obedient unto My Word? Stand still, ye **Shepherds**, and hearken unto the Lord your God.

20. I am weary of your wickedness; for ye are blind, and ye lead those who are blind. **My anger is kindled against all who oppose My Word.** My children stand alone; yet not alone, for I am with them. Ye persecute them when they deliver My Words unto you; and all men forsake them. Even as I, the Lord, was rejected and forsaken, so shall My children be. To them it is given to know the Mystery of the Kingdom of God; but to you, who profess to know Me, these are dark sayings: for **ye have not the Spirit of God in your midst.** Your eyes are blind, and your ears are deaf; therefore ye are in darkness, and ye feed My sheep with darkness.

21. I will speak My Words unto you again: Words which ye have read many times, which are as a parable unto you, because ye are disobedient unto Me.

22. "In My Father's Name ye shall cast out devils!"

Do you?

23. "Ye shall speak with new Tongues!"

Do you?

24. "If ye drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt you!"

"Ye shall take up serpents!"

Do you?

25. Ye shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover!"

Do you?

26. I, the Lord God, desire to speak to My people, by Prophecy, by Revelation, in Visions, Dreams and Tongues.

27. I can find but few who are willing for Me to work this way!

28. What is this work?

It is the indwelling Power of the Son of God! a Manifested Christ! Many have tasted the wonderful riches of God, and have gone back to the traditions of men! And why?

29. **Because**, when they have made known the Mysteries of God and the Glories of Heaven, ye **Shepherds** have treated them lightly! **Ye have trodden underfoot**—not man's imaginations, as ye suppose—but the Words of the Lord Jesus, whom ye profess to follow!

30. Unless ye turn unto Me **speedily**, I will empty your churches, which ye delight in; and will scatter your flocks; and will pour out My fury upon you—even as I did upon those in the city of Babylon. I will seek out those who are seeking for Me, and will hide them in My sure refuge; but ye shall howl and cry for the pangs that shall come upon you.

31. When I seek out My sheep, and heal My sick ones (which ye have left to die!) when I bind up the broken and bring those back (which ye have driven away!); then shall ye know that the Lord is God, and beside Him there is no God.

32. I know you not: ye have not the Power of God upon you or within you.

33. Ye are in darkness: else ye would see that My children are in the Light.

34. "He that knoweth My Commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth Me: and he that loveth Me shall be loved of My Father, and I will love him, and will manifest Myself to Him!"

35. **Shepherds! Shepherds! Shep-**

herds! Harken unto the Words of the Lord God, whom ye profess to follow.

36. Do you hear My Voice?

Do you see Me Face to face?

There are a few who know Me this way! and those are they who love Me, who give Me the Chief place in their hearts and lives. These become a Peculiar treasure unto My Father, because they are willing to become fools for His Glory.

37. **Shepherds**, what think ye of My Word? the Word which ye profess to know, yet know not, to believe yet believe not!

38. With what do ye feed My sheep? With your own words and imaginations! And ye rejoice when men speak well of you and praise you.

39. At whose hands will I require the blood of My people, in the day that is soon coming upon the earth?

40. The sheep follow the **Shepherd**!

41. Therefore, ye **Shepherds**, hearken unto Me. Ye obey not My Words! Ye fulfil not the commands of My Words! Ye starve My sheep! Those ye starve not, ye scatter! Those ye scatter not, ye kill! And ye delight in calling yourselves **Shepherds** of God!

42. I know you not. I am against all who reject My Words. They who reject My Words shall be rejected by My Father!

43. Have I not spoken words easily understood? Hear the Words of the Lord your God again, for I am in the Father and the Father in Me.

Repent,

Be Baptized: and ye shall **Receive the Holy Ghost.**

44. **Shepherds**, ye shall hear My Words. One teacheth baptism, and another teacheth it not! although I, the Lord, have commanded you to do even as I did, that ye might fulfil all righteousness! But ye do this not!

45. How can I baptize with My Mighty Powerful Spirit if ye will not obey My commands?

46. **Shepherds**, am I to be obeyed? or will ye go your own way? leading My people astray?

47. In the day when I shall judge you, ye will be without excuse; standing before My Father ashamed, confused, and fearful!

48. **Shepherds**, cease from your own works; ye are an abomination in My sight. Where are the green pastures and still waters, which I have purchased for My people?

49. Humble yourselves before Me, all ye who read these words.

50. **Shepherds**, woe be unto you! woe! woe! woe! if ye hearken not unto My words, and obey them not.

51. "To whom doth the Lord speak?" shall many of you say among yourselves; but ye shall know in your hearts that I have spoken unto you.

52. I speak unto every man who feedeth My sheep; though they are not fed with My Word. If they were fed with the Words which I would give them, they would be strong: sickness, sin, disease, and death would not be in the midst of them as it is to-day. For I, the Lord God, have purchased a wonderful Salvation for My people, by the Precious Blood of My dear Son Jesus, who is their Life.

53. **Shepherds**, where are the sick ones which I have commanded you to lay hands upon in My Father's Name? I say unto you, where are they?

54. Ye have not laid hands upon them, that I might heal them. And why?

Because ye choose to go your own ways! and the ways of your fathers before you.

55. Devils are indwelling people to-day. They shut them up in prison houses, and ye call not unto Me. Ye obey not My Words, that, in My Father's Name, ye shall cast out devils.

56. Oh, ye false shepherds! Woe be unto you; for your wickedness is very great, and ye tremble not at My Word. Therefore is Mine anger kindled against you!

57. **Shepherds**, have ye beheld the Lamb of God? Have ye gazed upon His Face? Have ye seen the Marks and Nail prints in His Hands and Feet? Have ye seen the crowned Head and the riven Side?

58. If ye had looked upon the suffering of the Saviour, ye would have been faithful unto His Word, and have yielded yourselves to Him; and He would have done mighty things in your midst. But ye believe Me not! Verily, I say unto you, he that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also, and greater works than these

shall he do, because I go to My Father. But ye will not obey Me, therefore My Word is unfruitful in your midst.

59. **Shepherds, shepherds, shepherds**, blessed are they who hear the Word of the Lord and **obey** it. This is the **Word** of the Lord, even the burden of the Word of the Lord: if ye had been **faithful** Shepherds, ye would understand the meaning of it, and I would give you the Word with which to feed My sheep, and My Words would be Truth and Justice.

60. Then would I be lifted up, and draw men unto Me.

Why do men not come unto Me?

Because they know Me not!

61. Ye have no light. Darkness has come upon you, and ye know not whither ye walk!

62. Therefore, ye **Shepherds**, hear the Word of the Lord your God, which ye have seen, and read, and know. "If any man hear My Voice and the Words which I speak unto him, and believe not, I judge him not; for I came not to judge the world, but to save all who shall believe on Me." He that rejecteth Me, and that will not receive My Words (**these Words**, ye shepherds) hath one who judgeth him. **The Word** which I have spoken shall judge him in that day: for I have not spoken of Myself, but the Father which sent Me, **He** gave Me the commandment what I should say, and to whom I should speak.

63. Therefore, he who receiveth whomsoever I send, receiveth **Me**; and he who receiveth Me, receiveth Him Who sent Me.

64. After speaking these Words to me, the Lord said to me: I will speak unto thee again, for Mine Anger is kindled against the false Shepherds.

III. On December 29th, 1919, while I was praying, the Lord Jesus again appeared unto me, and continued to speak His Words concerning the false Shepherds, or preachers, of to-day, as follows:—

2. **Shepherds, shepherds, shepherds**, hear the Word of the Lord! Hast thou warned My sheep to flee from the wrath to come? Great is the responsibility ye have taken upon yourselves, oh men! ye who stand up as

Preachers of My Word!

3. Ye **False** Shepherds! I have not called you to feed My sheep. Had I called you, ye would have been obedient unto My Word; and My sheep would know **Me** in the way that I desire them to: for they would **feel**, and **see**, and **know**, the **Power of God**; and would rejoice in the riches of Christ their Lord, and would praise and glorify Him!

4. Ye have set yourselves up as shepherds, and appear beautiful in the sight of men; but what saith the Lord God?

5. Ye **false** Shepherds! ye are whited sepulchres outwardly, but inwardly are full of sin: for ye are yet in your sins, not having been born of water, or of the Spirit.

6. Why will ye not obey My commands which ye read in My Word? Ye read them. Why read them, and do them not?

7. **Pride** is the chief cause of your disobedience; this is one of the greatest hindrances to My Work. Many have been, and shall be, blasted by pride, because they will not humble themselves before Me.

8. Soon, soon, soon, the Word of the Lord will be taken from you: for I speak unto you through My children and ye will not hear them.

And why?

9. Because the Words which I speak through them are not comfortable words, but Truth and Justice. In obeying them ye will have to give up your own ways and go the way of the Lord your God. Men will cease to praise you, and will speak evil of you, and will forsake you.

And why?

10. Because, when ye obey My Word and My commands, then I, the Lord, take up My abode in your heart; and those who know Me not seek to overthrow My Work.

But woe be unto you if ye hearken not unto My Words!

11. Thou ignorant shepherd, as thou readest these Words, turn unto the Lord thy God. Believe, and obey the commands of God; and thou shalt be delivered from the power of darkness, which causeth thee to err. Call unto Me, and I will hear thee and forgive all thy sin and ignorance which thou hast committed. As thou desirest

- est Me, so will I satisfy thee in accordance with My Word; and thou shalt go forth strong in My strength, rejoicing in the joy of thy Lord, but enduring many hardships, because he who treadeth the path that I trod will find many thorns. But the Glory of God, and the joy which cometh with obedience, will enable thee to look up and praise the Lord thy God.
12. As thou dost experience the mighty Power of God, thou wilt understand more fully what thou art saved from.
13. Therefore, turn unto Me; or thou shalt be numbered with those whose end is destruction!
14. Ye professing Christians, ye who have ceased to believe My Word and to hear My Voice! know ye not that the branch has no life but that which flows to it from the vine? Ye have no Life but that which flows from Christ to you, which is Spiritual Life; and this ye cannot have except ye obey the commands of the Lord God which He hath laid down for you in His Word.
15. Like Naaman of old, because I tell you to do a small thing and one which brings you no glory, ye refuse to obey! Had I asked you to do a hard thing ye would have been more willing, but ye go your own way, and delight to call yourselves the children of God!
16. I know you not: ye are of the world, and are full of corruption: your heart's delight is in the pleasures of the world: ye enter into places where the Lord cannot come: and then, on the Sabbath day, ye enter the buildings which ye call the temples of God! They are not My temples. There are but few Temples where I can enter; and these I find among My Children individually.
17. Ye professing Christians, think ye that ye can be saved by joining a particular church? or by saying many prayers?
18. Thy Salvation come from God the Father, through His dear Son Jesus Christ, who died for your sins, and is now living in the Presence of His Father in Heaven, that ye might be saved by His Precious Blood, believing His Word, obeying His Word, and glorifying God.
19. But ye plead not the Blood! ye believe not the Word! ye obey not the Word! neither do ye glorify God!
20. Therefore, hear ye the Word of the Lord, ye who profess to walk in the light, but stumble on in darkness. This darkness shall overtake you; for the Righteousness of God shall make manifest the children of Light; and darkness shall make manifest the children of the devil.
21. Beware then! for I have warned you through My Servants, that ye may know in that day—which is soon coming—that I have spoken unto you. Ye are unstable, wilful, not having the Spirit and Power of God upon you, not being rooted and grounded in Christ.
22. Ye professing Christians, if ye would humble yourselves before Me in penitence, then should My Spirit strive with you again, and give unto you another chance. If ye would cry unto Me, seeing your nothingness, your weakness, your great need; then would I answer you and bring into your hearts much joy, causing you to sing and shout praises unto your Lord.
24. Then would ye delight in obeying My Word, and your Lord would bless you by fulfilling the promises of His Word.
25. I cannot do much, for there are so few who obey Me; and those who obey Me not, shall not partake of the promises of My Word, for they are not worthy.
26. I, the Lord, stand before you as ye read these Words. Many shall say, "These Words are too bitter; He could not speak thus" But I say unto you, These are My Words.
27. I am the same Lord Who stretched out My Hands in healing, casting out devils and raising the dead. Can any man bring accusation against Me?
28. These are My Words, for by My Great Love have I spoken unto you. Yea, these Words are the Heart yearnings of your Lord, crying out unto you that ye should cease from following man, and follow they Lord wherever He may lead you.
29. Unless ye follow Me, great shall be your sorrow, and your repentance will be too late!
30. Ye people who read these Words and desire to go the Way of the Lord,

let go **your** own way, and seek after God: for the time is short and **ye are not saved!** Follow not the **shepherds who lead you astray.** Why do ye follow them? when ye can see and read in My Word that they are disobedient to My Commands!

31. Ye **people**, the shepherds feed not the flocks, and ye are starving! I, the Lord, will speak unto you: I will be your Shepherd, and will teach you. For My Heart is longing for My children, who are seeking **Me**; and they shall find Me, and will follow Me. They will obey the commands of My Word, and rejoice in the same, and be filled with the Spirit of God.

32. Ye **people**, who have been redeemed with the Precious Blood of Jesus, give up the way which ye have walked in these many years, and come unto Me, that ye may be filled with **Life.** Ye know that ye have no Life in your midst, for **ye obey men rather than God!**

33. Ye **people**, walk with your God alone. Give up everything; that ye may not perish with the congregation of unrighteous people. **Ye are deluded!** Satan is covering your eyes and your ears, lest ye see and hear the Mighty Power of God.

34. After speaking these words the Lord Jesus said to me:

I will speak unto thee again, and show thee the end of these false Shepherds.

IV. On December 30th, 1919, while I was waiting upon the Lord, He again appeared to me, dressed in a red garment, and said:—

My child, lovest thou Me? Art thou willing to bear much for thy Lord? to be rejected, despised, forsaken, and accused falsely by many people for My Name's sake, and for My Father's Glory?

3. As these words go forth, many shall turn unto Me, and great shall be the rejoicing of the angels in Heaven; for the time is very dark, and the sheep are hungry, starving, cold, sick, and drooping for the Spirit of Truth; which they cannot receive, because they see Me not, neither know Me; for I am in the Father and the Father in Me.

4. As they read these words and believe them, light shall come upon them; and they shall be saved, and

obey My Commands.

5. Many shall these Words cut asunder, as with a sword; for the sword of the Spirit shall separate the false shepherds from the true.

6. My faithful shepherds shall have sweet joy, and peace, and many crowns for their reward in the day that is soon coming upon the earth; but many shall not hearken unto these words, even as they did not hearken unto My servant Jeremiah. Their end shall be very bitter, when My Father shall require the blood of the flocks at their hands. Then shall My Father say, Depart from Me, ye shepherds, for I never knew you.

7. Then I saw the Lord Jesus and thousands upon thousands of clergy of every denomination and vast crowds of people were standing before His. At His side stood an angel holding in his hand a book, from which he read out the names of those who had been faithful.

8. As he called out their names I saw them enter into a green pasture and sit down with great joy in peace. The great bulk of those I saw, however, were commanded to depart, for the Lord Jesus said to them, **I never knew you.** The place to which these went was very dark and I could hear their cries and groans, and see sheets of flame leaping up and down.

9. Then again the Lord spake, saying:—

Shepherds, professing Christians and ye deluded people, have I not prophesied through My Prophet Joel that in the last days I would pour out My Spirit upon all flesh?

10. These are the last days! although ye believe it not. Soon shall the trumpet sound go through the whole earth, and from one end to the other will I gather My Own Sheep. They shall be overcome with joy and gladness at My coming.

11. Multitudes without number will be left behind to go through the tribulation which shall come upon the earth.

12. Awake! ye sleeping ones, ye deluded and ignorant, careless and indifferent ones. Turn unto the Lord your God. Obey My Word.

13. Repent of your wickedness, and humble yourselves before Me. Be Baptized by being immersed in

- water, which costs you nothing: and your obedience shall be counted unto you for Righteousness, and ye shall
- Receive the Gift of the Holy Ghost.**
14. Then shall ye know that the Lord your God is alive, for ye shall feel Him move within and upon you. Ye shall behold the Glories of Heaven while ye are still sojourners upon earth! For eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither hath it entered into the heart of man the things which God hath prepared for those who love Him: but God will reveal them unto you by His Spirit.
15. If thou dost not hearken unto the Word of God, I will make thee to become as the tower of Babel.
16. Man, who art thou, that thou shouldst disobey the Lord God? I have shown thee the Way to walk in, for I am the Way.
17. Ye false shepherds, ye professing Christians, ye deluded ones, ye people, not every man who saith, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the Kingdom of Heaven, but only those who love and obey the will of My Father Who is in Heaven.
18. Ye despise the Word which cometh from God! Harken, all ye despisers, unto the Lord your God.
19. Your end shall be destruction, unless ye love and obey My Word.
20. Ye False Shepherds and Professing Christians, ye have a beautiful form of Godliness and, in the sight of men, your righteousness is perfect.
21. But what saith the Lord God? Ye have no righteousness, for ye deny the Power of God, and shut Him out of your churches, and kill and drive away all My Children who have found Me!
- I care not for your churches or your buildings.
22. All that I require is a Temple, not made with hands, where I can speak unto My Children, reveal the Father's Glory, have sweet fellowship with them, and prepare them for their Home in Heaven.
23. My children must be familiar with Me. It is not enough to know the Lord thy God outwardly; thou must know Him as thy Friend, and the true Love of Christ shall flow within thy Spirit perpetually. Then ye shall the likeness of God be seen in lievers.
- thee, even the Divine Image of thy Father.
24. Have I not given thee children in the flesh resembling their earthly parents? So shall My children in the Spirit become like unto their Father, Who hath called them to become the sons of God.
25. My Children, who read these Words, take comfort in thy Lord, for He is with you. Forget thyself in thy love and service. Be beside thyself for thy Lord, and He shall pour out upon thee His Love, Joy and Peace. Let thy love come forth, and fear not man. For thy Lord's sake become a fool, for such fools are wise!
26. The world is drunken with sin, sickness and death, and My Children are few who work therein. Seek out My sheep, and I will feed thee that thou mayest feed them. They are shamefully treated: the shepherds have not fed them, neither healed them, nor pitied them; they stretch not forth a hand to save them! Therefore, Mine Anger is kindled against the shepherds, and against all who have a form of Godliness and have not My Spirit within them.
27. Ye Shepherds, know ye not that in rejecting My Word, ye are committing the unpardonable sin by your unbelief?
28. I say unto you again that the only way I can work is by the Holy Spirit of God.
29. Where cometh Prophecy? Visions? Healings? Miracles? Tongues? Interpretations? Through the Spirit of God—a Manifested Christ.
30. Is He in your midst when ye assemble together?
31. No! Ye know not the Lord! for ye will not have the Spirit of God among you.
32. I am speaking unto My Children in these last days; and every man, who heareth My Words and rejecteth them, will I reject before My Father in Heaven.
33. Therefore, all ye who desire to become obedient unto your Lord, and to follow His commandments; do ye know what ye must do?
34. Come out! and be separate! and shall be My Sons and Daughters; for ye cannot walk together with unbelievers.

35. The time cometh, and now is, when the children of God shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth, for He seeketh such to worship Him.

36. Man doth not live by bread alone; but by every Word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God shall man live. As ye come out and are separate, I will feed you, and ye shall know what it is to be taught of God, and to behold the mighty Power of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost manifested in humanity, and to behold the Glory of God established.

V. On December 31st, 1919, while I was waiting upon the Lord Jesus, He again appeared to me and said:—

These Words, which I have spoken shall go forth to the ends of the earth, and souls shall be added unto the Lord. As they believe and obey My Word, many shall be healed; and wonderful Miracles, Revelations, Visions, Tongues and Interpretations shall be made manifest unto those who love and follow Me.

3. The peoples' hearts are waxed hard, and I cannot find an entrance, for they have not learned of Me.

4. Therefore will I send My Word to many nations and tongues through My Own Sheep; for the shepherds have kept My Word from the people, and their hearts are cold and barren.

5. My Sheep, who are seeking Me, shall find Me; and they shall come out and be separate from those who profess to know Me, and who call themselves the children of God.

6. As they come out, they shall understand My Word; and they shall have no need that any man should teach them, for they shall all be taught by God.

7. I desire to speak through My children in these last days. Be faithful, therefore, unto Me, all ye who read these Words and who love Me; for the Words which I speak through you shall become a rich pasture and Living Waters to all who come unto Me and are obedient unto all My Commandments.

A MESSAGE TO JERUSALEM

I. Oh, Jerusalem, Jerusalem, that stonest the prophets that I send unto thee, have I not called thee from the rising up of the sun unto the going down of the same, and ye have

not hearkened unto Me. Therefore, I am against thee, saith the Lord.

2. Therefore, all ye who have rejected and will reject My words, ye shall become as dust that is scattered before the wind; thou shalt not return unto thy place, whether it be of honour or of dishonour: for the fury of the Lord is like unto a whirlwind that scattereth everything in its violence.

3. Ye will not be warned, ye will not be warned. Destruction swift and sure shall fall upon all those who will not hear the words of the Lord God: for He is from everlasting to everlasting.

4. The Majesty of God is so great that the angels cannot extol His greatness. There is nothing in the heavens or in the earth that can worship Him as He should be worshipped. Yea, He findeth more pleasure in the beast of the field and in the humblest little daisy that He hath made than in man whom He hath made in His own image to be for His praise, His purpose and His glory: for man seeketh his own glory before the glory of God. Therefore, man has lost favour with God in that he rejecteth the word of the Lord and seeketh not to glorify Him.

5. Unless ye turn unto Me and seek Me with all your hearts, ye shall likewise perish as those who will not be warned. Ye are lifted up, ye are lifted up; ye are altogether an abomination. Your hearts are filled with evil imaginations and work deceit. Ye make many prayers and call yourselves the children of God, but ye know Me not, ye know Me not.

6. I have spoken through My word and by My servants the prophets throughout all ages, and ye have not hearkened unto them. In that ye have not hearkened unto them ye have not hearkened unto Me: for it is I, the Lord, Who manifest My word through My children. Unto those who receive it, it bringeth Life; unto those who reject it damnation and death, saith the Lord.

II. Come ye out, come ye out from among them! From among whom? From those who have a form of godliness and deny the power of God. Who are they? Yea, they who call themselves the children of God, who meet together in My

Name—many occupied in doing many works. I know them not. Oh, My people, come ye out, come ye out and be ye separate, saith the Lord.

2. Few there be who will receive Me in their midst. Ofttimes I begin to work when I see a few of My children seeking Me with all their hearts. Then I manifest Myself in different ways unto them. Then what? They are abused and persecuted; the testimony of My Father's Power among them is not received. Therefore, come ye out, come ye out from among them and be ye separate, saith the Lord; and I will be a Father unto you, and ye shall become My sons and daughters, saith the Lord,

3. My children, My children, open thine heart wide that I, thy Lord, may enter. Art thou satisfied with the works and praises of men, which bring no real pleasure? In me ye shall have pleasure for evermore. As I enter in, all else becomes nothing and thy Lord is everything. My children, My children, all ye who have a desire after the things that are eternal, open thine heart wide—wide—that I thy Lord may enter. Then thou shalt find sweet fellowship and green pastures, and thy joy shall be like a cup that runneth over; thy countenance shall shine with the glory of God, and many people shall be drawn unto Me as they see the reflection of the Divine Image of the Son of God in thee.

4. I have sent forth My word to many people, but only a few have believed and accepted it. Great troubles shall fall upon those who seek not after God. Many who think they are in the fold shall not be numbered with that company who are worthy; and many who think they are not My children, the same shall be called the children of God. For thus saith the Lord, the first shall be last and the last first; for God is no respecter of persons. And why? For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see, and they that see might be made blind.

5. The world to-day is filled with people who profess to love, serve, obey and follow the Lord God. His Word is read by them, preached by them, expounded by them. To what end? Yea, there is emptiness, waste

and darkness from one end of the earth to the other. And why? Because the glorious light of the gospel of Jesus Christ, Who is the Son of God, has not shined in the hearts of the children of men. They call upon God, but they accept not His commands to do them with all their hearts.

6. Many say, when they read My word, Oh, this was only meant for the people of those days. Has God changed? Has His word lost its power? Is not thy Lord He Who changes not, the great Eternal Spirit of the Father, Who is the same yesterday, to-day and forever? Believe this, that the Lord thy God is the same, yesterday, to-day, and forever.

7. Pause a moment and consider the works of the Lord. Was it not He Who created the heavens, the sun, the moon, the stars, day and night, summer and winter, and all things? Did He not speak unto His children through all the ages, and will He not continue to speak throughout all ages?

8. Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem, My people, why will ye continue in your own ways and reject My words which I have spoken unto you? Why will ye not seek after the Living God? Turn unto Me, turn unto Me: for I am the Lord and beside Me there is none other. Where is thy joy, thy righteousness and peace? Yea, ye are empty: ye find no pleasure in that which ye delight in.

9. Seek ye the Lord while He may be found; for His coming draweth nigh. Soon will ye seek to hide yourselves from the Presence of the Lord. The rocks and the mountains shall not cover thee, neither the caves, nor the earth hide thee from the Presence of the Lord. Punishment swift and sure shall fall upon all those who reject the Lord their God.

10. Oh My people, My people, hearken unto the words of the Lord Thy God: for He loveth thee and with loving kindness He would draw thee unto Himself. Hath He not purchased thee with His precious blood for His own possession? Will ye not yield yourselves unto Him, that He may find pleasure in His people?

11. Ye continue in your own way and believe not the word of God! The

day is soon coming when the arm of humble yourselves before Him and the Lord shall be stretched forth in call upon Him, that He may deliver judgment upon the children of men. thee from all thy sins: for He hath That day shall bring darkness and paid the price with His precious blood, confusion. Horror and desolation by Whose stripes ye are saved and shall fill the hearts of all those whose healed. desire has not been after God.

III. These are the last days spoken of by the prophet Joel, in which God promised to pour out His Spirit upon all flesh. Yea, He hath done this, but only a few have accepted His Spirit. To many He hath appeared; to many He hath manifested His Presence by visions, by prophecy, by tongues, by miracles, by healings, and by many wonderful works of God. This is the manifested Power of the Son of God, Who is Jesus Christ the Lord and The Word of God.

2. Yet for all this ye believe not the Lord, and ye persecute the people of God whose delight is in obeying the Word of the Lord. Ye attribute My Power through My children—which is no longer them, but I in them—to the power of Satan!

3. Know ye not that I have purchased My children as temples where I can enter and through whom I can speak and manifest the mighty power of God? for I promised that if I went away, I should also come back again. Believe ye this?

4. Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem, who continuest to stone My prophets which I send unto thee, will ye continue to reject thy God? Thou didst reject Him when He came to earth as a little child. Did He not humble Himself leaving all the glorious Majesty of the kingdom of heaven, that thou mightest be made partakers of that same kingdom? Did I not speak unto My servants the prophets, men of your own nation? What saith the prophet Isaiah?

5. "He is despised and rejected, a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief. He was despised and we esteemed Him not. Hath He not borne our sorrows and our griefs? Was He not forsaken of God and afflicted? All we like sheep without a shepherd have gone astray. We have turned and gone every man his own way; and the Lord God has laid upon Him the iniquity of us all."

6. Seeing that the iniquity of thy sins was laid upon the Son of God,

7. Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem, if thou canst not see the darkness that is stealing over the land, believe the word of the Lord: for soon that darkness will overtake thee unawares. Then shalt thou grope, seeking deliverance and Salvation from the Lord too late! too late! too late!! As thou hast rejected the Son of the Living God, so shalt thou be rejected by the Father of the Son.

IV. Oh, Jerusalem, Jerusalem, be ye warned, be ye warned: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh. Soon, yea, very soon thy glory shall depart from thee and nothing shall cover thy sins. Thy profession is an abomination in the eyes of the Lord thy God.

2. Call ye upon the Lord your God, that He may empty thee of all thine idols and uncleanness and hypocrisy. When ye have become emptied, then the Lord, the Son of the Living God, even Jesus, will take up His abode in thine heart, and ye shall become a pleasure and a delight unto the Lord your God.

Then shall He make known unto thee the mysteries of the kingdom, which, to those who know Me not, are as parables and dark sayings. Then, like My servant Paul, many of you shall have the experience of being caught up into the third heaven and witnessing the glorious revelations of the kingdom of God. Then shall ye say, We are come into the heavenly Jerusalem, even into the city of the Living God.

4. Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem, unless ye turn unto the Lord, thine inheritance shall not be the glorious kingdom where the Lamb of God dwelleth: thine inheritance shall be eternal death.

5. Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem, I have called thee from the rising up of the sun unto the going down of the same. Soon shall the Sun of Righteousness be hidden from thee, yea, from all those who persistently forsake the Lord their God.

V. Awake, awake, cry aloud ye

slotful and indifferent daughters of might walk and seek the Lord, but Zion, that the Lord thy God may deliver and quicken thee. Let him who calleth himself by My Name, examine himself. Consider and see if there be any spiritual depth, and hunger and thirst alter the Righteousness of God. Lord is at hand.

VII. Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem, how long will ye continue in your own way? Soon shall ye receive the reward of thy sins: for the day of the Lord is at hand.

2. Then I beheld a very broad road hath desired His praise and His glory crowded with people at the far end above all things? Where are the sons of which I saw flashes of fire and of God, the Righteous children? To heard peals of thunder. After this I whom hath the Lord appeared? heard the Lord say:

3. Search the scriptures and read 3. Come unto Me, come unto Me. In therein that He who is Lord of lords, Me ye shall have life: for I am Life, King of kings, God Omnipotent, the the very substance of the Father. humble Man of Nazareth, hath made Come unto Me and thou shalt be numbered with those whose reward is known the mighty Power of God unto Eternal Life.

4. Praise ye the Lord! By the word of His mouth were the heavens made: the earth and all the inhabitants therein.

5. What saith the word of the Lord? VIII. Thou canst only comprehend the greatness of God when thou seest the smallness of thyself. A man Seek ye My Face. The souls of My walking on the earth, seen from a children cry, Thy Face, Lord, will I mountain, is a mere speck, scarcely seek. To many of My children have perceptible to the eye of man.

I manifested Myself, even as I did 2. Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem, be- unto My servant Moses. To others of hold the greatness of thy God. Lift Him up, lift Him up and be content to remain where thou art—a mere speck of dust in the eyes of thy Lord.

3. Think ye that ye shall escape because thy sins were taken and carried upon the Son of God? Yea, they who commit sin shall, unless they repent out of an honest heart, be cast into outer darkness.

4. The desire of the Lord thy God is that ye shall walk with God. How thine eyes behold the wondrous beauty empty and hard are the hearts of My of thy Lord: for He is the altogether children today. The Lord desireth Lovely One. There is nought that thee, yea, with a great and tender love.

5. My little ones, My desire for thee is that ye show forth the praises of Him Who hath called thee out of darkness into His marvellous light. The Lord thy God is alive for evermore, the all-loving Just One, the unchangeable Jehovah. Therefore, repent, repent before the fury of the Lord falleth upon thee.

IX. What saith the word of God? Hath He changed? Has His word become a lie? Then hearken to that which ye have read in My word and believe not. He sent prophets among them to bring them again unto the Lord their God. And what? They spoke against them and would not

10. Oh My children, all ye who are following the Lord thy God, I say, continue ye so to walk: for the time is coming, yea, is near at hand, when they who walk not with Me will cry for the day of the Lord, in which they

harken unto the Lord.

2. As thy Lord is the same yesterday, to-day and forever, be ye warned, be ye warned: flee from the wrath to come. Ye cannot say among yourselves, when the judgments of the Lord shall fall upon thee, that thy God hath not warned thee.

4. Ye must be born again, ye must be born again. Ye are still in your sins; your garments are defiled with your old nature. Ye must be born of incorruptible seed—even the Spirit of the Living God.

5. Come, come unto Me and be ye saved. Repent, and be baptized, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Ye shall be filled with the Power of God, as ye follow and obey thy Lord ye shall become a praise unto God.

6. These signs shall follow them that believe: in My Name they shall cast out devils; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover: they shall speak with tongues and prophesy. Therefore, ye lukewarm and professing Christians, it is high time for thee to seek the Lord with all thine heart, that thou mightest believe and these signs follow.

7. Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. He that loveth the world, the love of the Father is not in him. The world is empty of My Presence and the people are going their own way, which leadeth away from the Father: for I am the Way.

8. Many of you who read this word will say, A wicked and an adulterous generation seeketh after a sign, and

there shall no sign be given.

9. Thus the Lord Jesus said He would demonstrate the word He had just given. Immediately I beheld a number of people assembled in a room and crying to God. I heard two of them pray, Oh, Lord God, in Thy word Thou hast said, These signs shall follow them that believe; in My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover; they shall speak with tongues and prophesy. Having prayed thus, they laid hands upon a crippled man and then upon a blind man and both were instantly made whole.

10. Again the Lord appeared unto Me and said, This is how I desire My people to serve and follow Me.

11. Then I beheld other congregations of different denominations and the Lord said, These are they who are satisfied with their own works, and will not let Me work the works of My Father in their midst.

12. Therefore, hear the words of the Lord God, Come ye out from among them and be ye separate: for the day of the Lord is soon coming when He will scatter the unbelieving and the professing Christians who make a vain show.

13. The Lord thy God is the same yesterday, to-day and forever; therefore remember, in the day that is soon coming, He has warned thee by His servants, whether ye will forbear.

14. Thus endeth the words of this prophecy of the Lord, Who is the unchangeable, omnipotent God, the Father of thy Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.

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
